### THE CROWN LANDS ORDINANCE, 1915.

#### NOTICE.

*Sale of Grant in Respect of Government  
Godown Plots, Ndia Kuu, Mombasa.*

NOTICE is hereby given that a grant in respect of the plot specified in the schedule hereto, will be sold by auction by Messrs. Datto & Co., on the premises, Ndia Kuu, Mombasa, on March 17th, 1923, at 10-30 a.m.

A plan of the site may be seen at the Public Map Office of the Land Department, Nairobi, or at the Land Office, Mombasa, or may be had on application to either of the above offices on payment of Sh. 1/- post free.

The right to withdraw the plot from the auction at any time prior to the hour of the sale is reserved to Government.

#### CONDITIONS.

1. The sale shall include the plot and the building standing thereon.

2. The highest bidder shall be the purchaser, and, if any dispute arises as to any bidding, the plot shall be put up again at the last undisputed bidding.

3. The amount of the advance of each bidding shall be regulated by the Auctioneer and no bidding shall be retracted.

4. The purchaser shall pay to the Auctioneer immediately on the fall of the hammer a deposit of 25% of his purchase money. In default of such payment the plot may be immediately re-offered for sale and any subsequent bid by the person who has made default may be ignored or refused.

5. The balance of the purchase money together with the rent due from the 1st April to the 31st December, 1923, the survey fees and the fees payable for the preparation and registration of the grant and the stamp duty payable in respect of the grant shall be paid to the Land Officer at the Land Office, Mombasa, within seven days from the date of the sale, and upon such payments being duly made the purchaser shall, subject to the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance, 1915, and if the conditions of sale have been complied with be entitled to a grant of the plot, which grant shall be presented to him for execution as soon as conveniently may be.

Provided that the balance of the purchase money shall not be payable within the time stated or thereafter unless and until the Land Officer can present to the purchaser the grant of the plot duly executed.

6. The lease shall be for 99 years and shall commence from the 1st April, 1923, and the rent shall be payable from that date.

7. No alteration to the existing building shall be made nor any new building erected on the plot unless plans, drawings, elevations and specifications thereof shall have been previously submitted to and approved by the Land Officer or such other person as he may appoint.

8. The purchaser shall bear the cost of deeds, stamp-duty, registration and survey fees as shown in the schedule hereto.
