THE CUSTOMS TARIFF ORDINANCE, 1927.

NOTICE is hereby given that as from 1st May, 1928, the provisions of the Customs Management Ordinance, 1926, the Customs Tariff Ordinance (Chapter 50 of the Revised Edition), and the Customs Tariff Ordinance, 1927, will be strictly applied to goods imported into or exported from the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya across the Kenya-Italian East African frontier.

In order to facilitate the proper control of this traffic His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to appoint Wajir a Port of Entry for purposes of Customs, with effect from 1st January, 1928, and arrangements for the establishment of a Customs office and godown at Wajir are being made accordingly.

On and from that date, all goods imported into the Colony of Kenya *via* the Kenya-Italian East African frontier must be produced for Customs entry and examination, and the proper duties chargeable thereon under the Customs Tariff Ordinances must be paid before delivery can be allowed. Goods intended for export must be similarly produced and entered prior to transportation to Italian East Africa.
