### **An Ordinance to Alter the Time within the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya.**

30th June, 1928.

Date of commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as “ the Alteration of Time Ordinance, 1928.” Short title.

2. At and after midnight on the 30th day of June, 1928, time within the Colony and Protectorate shall be deemed to be and shall be three hours fast on Greenwich mean time. Alteration of local time.

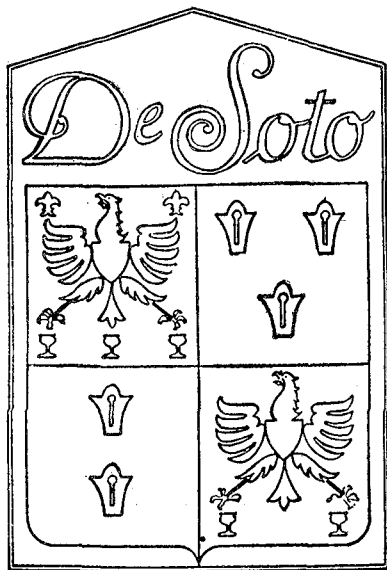
