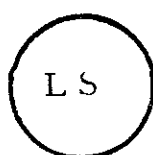

PASSPORT AGREEMENT WITH GERMANY

IT is notified for general information that an agreement was concluded with the German Government on the 3rd of December, 1927, for the mutual abolition of visas between Great Britain and Germany, and that the agreement has now been extended, with effect from the 1st of January, 1929 so that—

(1) German nationals do not require British visas to their passports to enable them to enter any non-self-governing British Colony, except Malta, any British Protectorate, and the Mandated Territories of the British spheres of Togoland and the Cameroons

(2) British subjects, and British protected persons provided with passports describing them as such, do not require German visas to their passports to enable them to enter German territory

This arrangement does not absolve German nationals on the one hand and British subjects and British-protected persons on the other from compliance with the immigration regulations in force from time to time

CONDITIONS OF SALE

(a) AUCTION

- 1 Each plot will be auctioned separately.
- 2 The amount of the advance of each bid will be regulated by the auctioneer, and no bidding shall be retracted.
- 3 The highest bidder will be the purchaser but if any dispute arise as to any bid, the plot will be reoffered at the last undisputed bid.
- 4 Each purchaser shall pay to the auctioneer immediately on the fall of the hammer a deposit of 25% of the purchase money. In default of such payment, the plot may be immediately reoffered for sale, and any subsequent bid by the person who has made default may be ignored or refused.

Provided that the balance of the purchase money shall not be payable within the time stated or thereafter, unless and until the Commissioner for Local Government, Lands and Settlement can present to the purchaser the grant duly executed.

7 Subject to the proviso contained in Condition No 6, if the amounts therein mentioned are not paid as therein laid down within 7 days from the date of the sale the Commissioner for Local Government Lands and Settlement may order the deposit made by the purchaser to be forfeited, and the purchaser shall have no further claim to the grant of the plot.

(b) GENERAL

1 The Government or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon any plot, and lay and have access to water mains service pipes telegraph or telephone wires, and electric mains of all descriptions whether overhead or underground, and the grantees shall not erect any building in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing routes, main or service pipes, or the telegraph or telephone wires and electric mains aforementioned.

2 No building shall be erected on any plot unless plans (including block plan showing the position of the buildings) drawings, elevations and specifications thereof shall have been previously approved by the Authority, and by the Commissioner for Local Government Lands and Settlement or such other person as he may appoint. Such plans, etc. shall be submitted in triplicate to the Resident Commissioner Kitale for necessary action.

3 The term of each grant will be 99 years from the 1st day of April, 1929.

4 The purchaser shall erect within two years of the commencement of his grant a building of approved design constructed of stone burnt brick, or concrete, on proper foundations.

5 The grantee shall not at any time subdivide the plot or assign, sublet or otherwise dispose of any portion of the plot without the previous written consent of the Governor.

6 Any building erected shall conform to a building line decided upon by the Authority.

(c) SPECIAL

(1) In respect of Business Plots (Schedule I)

1 At no time during the term of the grant shall any building erected on the plot be used for residential purposes, and the plot and the buildings erected shall be used for business purposes only.

2 The grantee shall not at any time during the term of the grant erect any building or buildings so as to cover more than 90% of the area of the plot.

Provided that in no case shall the area of any such business plot required to remain unbuilt on be less than 300 sq ft, and that the said area shall be free from any erection thereon above the level of the ground except latrine accommodation constructed in accordance with all laws and by-laws in force relating thereto, and in accordance with a design approved by the Authority.

Such open space shall be at the rear of the building and shall extend along the entire width of the building or for a distance of not less than 30 ft whichever shall be the less, and the distance across such open space from every part of the building to the rear boundary of the plot shall be not less than 10 ft.

3 At no time during the term of the grant shall any plot or any portion thereof or any building erected on the plot be used for the purpose of carrying on any trade or business which has been or may be declared dangerous or offensive by notice in the Official Gazette

4 Verandahs may be erected within a road reserve with the previous consent of the Authority, and must conform to a building line decided upon by such Authority

(2) *In respect of Residential Plots (Schedule II)*

1 No building shall at any time during the term of the grant be used for any purpose other than that of a dwelling-house

2 At no time during the term of the grant shall more than one dwelling house with the necessary offices and outbuildings be erected on any plot without the written consent of the Governor

3 The grantee shall not at any time during the term of the grant erect any building or buildings so as to cover more than one half the area of the plot

4 All outbuildings, offices etc., shall be properly sited and screened from view to the satisfaction of the Authority and shall be kept so screened during the term of the grant

LOCUST REPORT to 8 2 29

KERIO PROVINCE

West Suk—Hopper swarms 40 acres at Kamunono being destroyed. Infestation at Maerich 130 acres, hoppers now cleared up. Rain is threatening.

Elgeyo and Kerio River—Still clear of hoppers.

North and South Turkana—No operations report to hand.

Njemps Baringo—A large number of hoppers in Kaipceddo are dying due to heat and absence of food.

Large swarms destroyed at Rukus, several flying swarms were burnt at night.

Nodol—Numerous hopper swarms destroyed.

Nattan—Now free of hoppers.

Legumulum—Hopper swarms under destruction.

NORTHERN FRONTIER PROVINCE

Staff withdrawn. One officer transferred for work in the Thiraka District, of Meru Reserve where there are hoppers. It is reported that of the whole Northern Frontier Province the hoppers in approximately 5,000 square miles were dealt with. As the Province is over 100,000 square miles in extent work was concentrated in the area which offered the most reasonable facilities and opportunities for destruction. At the most sanguine estimate not more than ten per cent of the hatchings in the Northern Frontier Province were destroyed.

UKAMBA PROVINCE

Kilue—Half of the staff has been evacuated there are great hopes that the hopper infestation of the entire area will be overcome.

Konzo Tsavo—Staff withdrawn. A proportion of the swarms matured into fliers. The country was found to be extremely difficult in parts.

Lor—The position is reported as entirely satisfactory. Work is proceeding in Kilimuri, Serengeti, Mbololo and Mjunje. No report to hand from the Athi River area. There are no hoppers on the boundary south of Taveta.

MASAI RESERVE

Staff withdrawn. All hoppers found have been destroyed. Eggs are not suspected in the Nyiri Desert.

COAST AREAS

Lamu—Hopper infestation not severe. Destruction complete.

Tana River—Hopper infestation severe, and where feasible destruction continued, but it is feared that a large proportion has matured.

Malindi—Hoppers practically eradicated.

Kilifi—Entirely clear of hoppers.

A preliminary calculation places the hopper destruction in Kenya at approximately 25 per cent of the whole infestation.

FLYING SWARMS

The northerly movement of swarms in the Northern Frontier has continued. There are, however, large swarms moving north from the region of Fort Hall through Nyeri District. Damage is still being done to native crops in the Keruguya area.

Swarms on the Sabaki River, the Coast and Digo District generally have done much damage so that a food shortage is expected.

No reports of damage have as yet come from Elgeyo, and on account of the great destruction of hoppers in Kerio Province, unless flying swarms enter from elsewhere, the emission of swarms from that area will not be great.

A flying swarm at great height travelled northwards on the 7th February over the Rift Valley in the region of Gilgil. There is a large flying swarm in the Thomson's Falls area.

Eye witnesses report the presence of a very large flock of white locust birds in the Nanyuki District, the massed flock on the ground having the appearance of a huge field of snow.

There are reports of flying swarms in the Nairobi area, which are very close to coffee shambas. Coffee in Ithanga, in addition to having been decimated has suffered on account of the breaking of the wood and locusts have eaten coffee berries. Smoke fires were found to be most effective in moving locusts off bushes, and farmers are using old oil and crude oil to create denser and more permanent smudges. The oil is poured on the fires from time to time. It is suggested that flaming torches made of tow soaked in crude oil and enclosed in wire netting, if drawn about the headlands give a more effective smoke screen.

Tanganyika reports considerable damage to native crops, and that the general tendency of swarms is to move in a southerly direction.

No swarms are reported from the Trans Nzoia, Piteau, Lake and Nakuru areas.

It is notified for general information that no staff is available for the purpose of assisting occupiers to drive locusts from plantations. Communications regarding foodstuffs should be addressed to the Director of Agriculture.

THE CROWN LANDS ORDINANCE
(Cap 140, Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya)

AUCTION OF FARMS

THE grants of the farms specified in the Schedule hereto, will, subject to the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance (Chapter 140 of the Revised Laws of Kenya), be offered for sale at the Railway Club, Nairobi, commencing at 10 a.m., on Monday, the 25th March, 1929. Plans of the farms may be seen at the Public Map Office, Survey and Registration Department, Nairobi, or may be had on application to the Survey General on payment of Shs 3, post free, in respect of each plan required.

The right to withdraw any farm from the auction is reserved to the Commissioner for Local Government, Lands and Settlement.

CONDITIONS OF SALE

- 1 Each farm will be auctioned separately.
- 2 These farms are in the Highlands, and purchase will therefore be confined to Europeans only (or their accredited agents), in conformity with the decision of His Majesty's Government.
- 3 The highest bidder will be the purchaser, and if any dispute arise as to any bidding, the farm will be put up again at the last undisputed bid.
- 4 The amount of the advance of each will be regulated by the auctioneer, and no bid shall be retracted.
- 5 Each purchaser shall pay to the auctioneer, immediately on the fall of the hammer, a deposit of 10% of his purchase money, and should the same be tendered by cheque such cheque must be accompanied by a Banker's guarantee. In default of such payment the farm may be immediately re-offered for sale, and any subsequent bid by the person who has made default may be ignored or refused.
- 6 The balance of the purchase money may be paid in full to the Surveyor General on or before the 1st April, 1929, or may be paid in nine equal annual instalments payable on the 1st day of January in each year, the 1st instalment being payable on the 1st January, 1930, and the purchaser

shall inform the Surveyor General on or before the 1st April, 1929, which method of payment he desires to adopt.

7 If the purchaser shall have elected to pay the balance of the purchase money by instalments no assignment of the land granted or any part shall be valid until the whole of the purchase money shall have been paid.

8 The rent due to the 31st day of December, 1929, the survey fees and the fees payable for the preparation (90/-), and registration (20/-) of the grant, and the stamp duty payable (approximately 2% *ad valorem*) in respect of the grant and, if the purchaser shall have elected to pay the balance of the purchase money in full, the balance of the purchase money, shall be paid to the Surveyor General at the Survey and Registration Department, Nairobi, on or before the 1st April, 1929, and upon such payments being duly made, the purchaser shall, subject to the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance (Chapter 140, Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya), and, if the conditions of sale have been complied with, be entitled to a grant of the farm, which grant will be presented to him duly executed as soon as conveniently may be.

9 If the payments mentioned in Condition No 8 are not made on or before the 1st April, 1929, the Commissioner for Local Government, Lands and Settlement may order that the deposit paid by the purchaser be forfeited to the Government, and in such case the purchaser shall have no further claim to a grant of the farm.

10 The grants will be under the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance (Chapter 140 of the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya), and the Registration of Titles Ordinance (Chapter 142 of the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya), and will be for 999 years commencing from the 1st day of April 1929. Provided that the balance of the purchase money shall not be payable within the time stated or thereafter unless and until the Commissioner for Local Government, Lands and Settlement can present to the purchaser the grant duly executed.

7 Subject to the proviso contained in Condition No. 6, if the amounts therein mentioned are not paid as therein laid down within seven days from the date of the sale, the Commissioner for Local Government, Lands and Settlement may order the deposit made by the purchaser to be forfeited, and the purchaser shall have no further claim to the grant of the plot.

(B) GENERAL

1 The Government or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon any plot and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes, telegraph or telephone wires, and electric mains of all descriptions, whether overhead or underground, and the grantees shall not erect any building in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing routes, main or service pipes, or the telegraph or telephone wires and electric mains aforementioned.

2 No building shall be erected on any plot unless plans (including block plan showing the position of the buildings), drawings, elevations and specifications thereof shall have been previously approved by the Authority and by the Commissioner for Local Government, Lands and Settlement, or such other person as he may appoint. 1 The plots enumerated in Schedule No. II may be used for the combined purpose of business and residence, those in Schedule No. I shall be used for business purposes only.

2 In the case of plots to be used for the combined purposes of business and residence, not more than one half of the area of any such plot shall be built over.

3 In the case of plots to be used for business purposes only, not more than ninety per cent. of the area of any such plot shall be built over.
