PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

REGISTRATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR 1934.

PERSONS desirous of being registered as contractors for the execution of public works during the year 1934, are invited to apply as directed below. In the case of contractors already registered for the year 1933, confirmation only of the fact that they wish to be registered for the year 1934 is required. The applicant should, however, state if he is desirous of executing works in the divisions and of the class for which he has already been registered in 1933.

2. Applications in triplicate should be addressed to the Director of Public Works, P.O. Box 662, Nairobi, and the covers endorsed "Registration of Contractors."

3. Applications should be submitted before 25th February, 1934, but applications received subsequent to that date will receive consideration if thought desirable. The applicant should supply the following information:—

- (1) A statement showing in which executive divisions of the Public Works Department he wishes to undertake the execution of works. A map showing the boundaries of each division may be inspected at the Public Works Divisional Headquarters Offices at Nairobi, Mombasa, Kisumu, Eldoret and Nyeri.

- (2) A statement showing the classes of work for which he desires to be registered under the following heads:—

- (a) New buildings.
- (b) Alterations to and maintenance of buildings.
- (c) Plumbing and sanitation work in connexion with buildings.
- (d) Electrical work connected with buildings.
- (e) Supply of material for road work.
- (f) Township drainage works.
- (g) Transport.

- (3) Particulars of any works already undertaken on a contract basis, stating the approximate value of each.

- (4) The names of at least two references who may be asked to certify with regard to the applicant's financial stability, suitability for registration and ability to undertake and carry out work in a satisfactory manner.

4. The Director of Public Works reserves the right to refuse to register any applicant for any reason whatsoever should he think fit to do so.

5. The names of contractors who are found to be unsatisfactory for any reason will be struck off the list, and tenders from them will not be invited unless and until they are reinstated.

MAIZE AND WHEAT CONDITIONING
PLANT, KILINDINI.

REFERRING to General Notice No. 22 of 8th January, 1930, the charges set out in paragraph 3 thereof are hereby amended insofar as they affect maize of the 1933-1934 export season, that is to say, maize of the crop harvested at the end of 1933 and the beginning of 1934, as follows:—

- (a) For maize which has been rejected in the process of grading at Kilindini and is received for treatment at the Plant, a charge of 50 cents per bag will be made.
- (b) A charge of 40 cents per bag will be made on all maize consigned direct from up-country stations to the Conditioning Plant, provided however that the Chief Grader and Inspector shall give preference to maize rejected in the process of grading at Kilindini Pier and sent to the Plant for conditioning.

LOCUST REPORT, 11TH JANUARY, 1934.

The Red Locust.—In the report issued on the 4th January, reference was made to the accelerated northerly movement of flying swarms of the red locust in Tanganyika Territory which had by then almost reached the Central Railway. This northerly movement has continued and the swarms are advancing at various points on a line from Tanga to Tabora. One swarm has crossed the boundary into Kenya at a point about forty miles from the coast and it is expected that other swarms will cross the border in the near future.

The situation is being very closely watched and reports will be issued regularly. 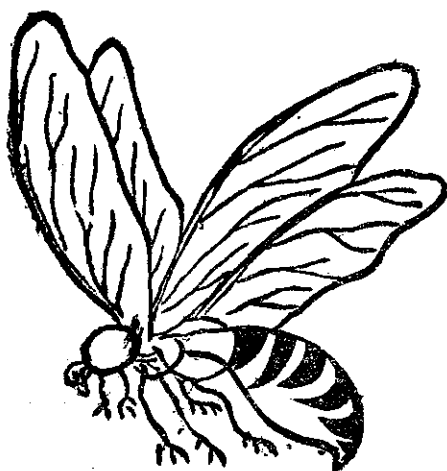

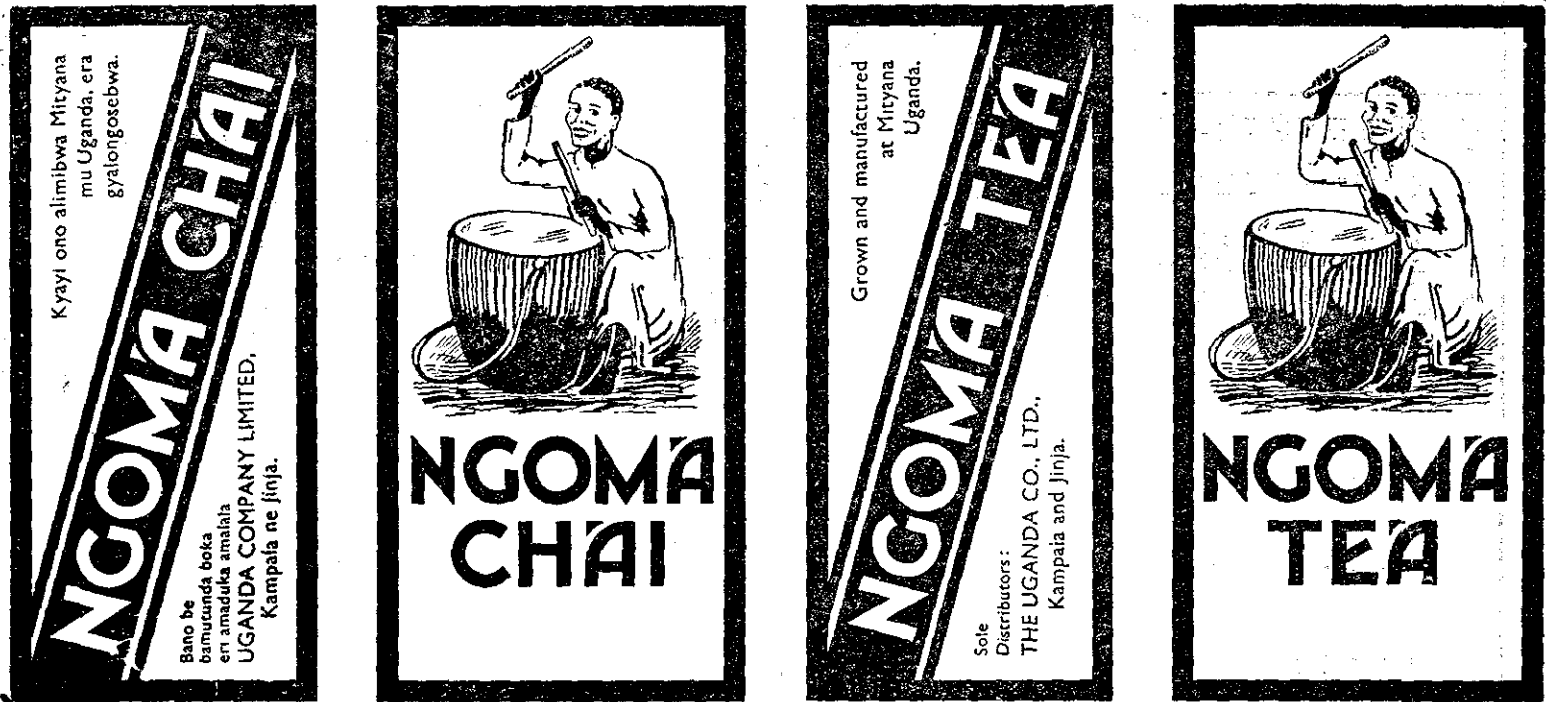
