MEETING OF LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

I, Joseph Aloysius Byrne, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, a Knight of Grace of the Venerable Order of the Hospital of Saint John of Jerusalem, having the honorary rank of Brigadier-General in His Majesty's Army, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Instructions under the Royal Sign Manual and Signet, dated the 29th day of March, 1934, do hereby direct that a session of the Legislative Council be held at the Memorial Hall, Nairobi, on Tuesday, the 24th day of April, 1934, at 11 a.m.
