GOVERNMENT NOTICE No. 439

THE CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE, 1926.

ORDER.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by section 47 of the Customs Management Ordinance, 1926, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to prohibit, as from the 1st day of August, 1934, the importation into the Colony of all condensed milk containing less than 9 per centum milk fat.

Save that the Commissioner of Customs may permit the importation into the Colony of consignments of such milk up to and including the 22nd day of August, 1934, if it is proved to his satisfaction that such consignments were ordered prior to the date of the publication of this Order.
