RABIES PROGRESS REPORT.

With the exception of two further positive confirmed cases of rabies which can be considered extensions of the outbreaks reported in the Soy-Turbo and Kakamega District in August, no other outbreaks have been reported since the publication of the last progress report in August.

15 positive cases of rabies have been reported this year: 11 occurred in the jackal and 4 in the dog.

A general appeal has been made to the District Councils, Farmers Associations and the Local Native Councils in the districts, where rabies is prevalent and has been prevalent, to assist the department in exterminating the jackal, in addition to the control of the number of dogs, with the object of preventing accumulation of rabies carriers, particularly pariahs wandering at large.

Poison baiting has been carried out in the Soy-Turbo, Hoey's Bridge and Upper Kipkarren River areas, the Kakamega township and certain locations in the North and Central Kavirondo Native Reserves.

Although the results of baiting in the settled areas have been small, owing to the sparsity of rabies carriers, considerable success has been obtained in the reduction of rabies carriers in the other areas.

LOCUST REPORT, 15TH OCTOBER, 1934.

KENYA.

The Red Locust.—During the last fortnight the following swarms of flying locusts have been reported.

On 1st October a medium swarm was seen at Mtito Andei moving in a north-westerly direction. This swarm was observed at Masongaleni on the 2nd and was estimated to be about 3 square miles in extent.

A small swarm was reported on 1st October to be doing considerable damage to sugar cane at Ramisi.

Numerous small swarms have passed through the Ukamba Reserve flying in a north-westerly direction, but doing little damage.

From Nyeri a small swarm was observed on the 1st October coming from the Fort Hall direction. This swarm split up into three portions, one flying in a north-easterly direction towards Narro Moru, another in a westerly direction whilst the third remained stationary a few miles south of Nyeri. Damage was negligible, being confined to the small millet crop planted in August. Maize is ripening off and was not attacked.

The swarm last reported at Kericho as having entered the Mau Forest has now left it again and is located partly in the Itare Valley and partly in the Sotik.

A large and very dense swarm was observed at Kajiado a few days ago flying south.

From Kitui a small swarm was reported flying in a north-westerly direction on the 4th October, and some damage to grazing and trees was done.

On the 11th October a large swarm was observed about nine miles south of Ngong flying in a westerly direction.

Besides those enumerated above several minor swarms have been reported from Voi, Konza, Kikuyu and other centres, but no serious damage has been recorded.

The specimens examined still reveal no indications of approaching maturity, nor is there as yet any sign of the typical yellow colouration of the males, which takes place shortly before mating time and is a sure indication that layings are imminent.

Information has just been received that a very large swarm was observed in the Kilifi area flying west over Bamba on the 5th October.
