TENDERS are invited for the supply of from 150 to 200 head of cattle during the remainder of the year for the preparation of anti-rinderpest serum and vaccine. Cattle should be two or more years old and from 450 lb. live weight upwards. They must be susceptible to rinderpest, and the tenderer must give an assurance that they have never been immunized (double inoculated) or vaccinated against rinderpest or been in contact with the disease. Any cattle that prove not to be susceptible to rinderpest to be exchanged for fresh animals. Animals to be subject to veterinary inspection prior to despatch. Tenders should be for the supply of animals in lots of ten or more, and should indicate when delivery can be given. The average age and approximately the average weight of the animals should be stated. Quotations should be per pound live body weight, f.o.r. supplier's nearest station or f.o.r. Kabete.
