LOCUST REPORT, 13TH DECEMBER, 1935.

THE RED LOCUST.

Kenya.

 $Northern\ Frontier\ Province. — No\ locusts\ reported.$

Central Province.—The swarm which passed Narok on 9th November was reported on 19th November to be present at Donyo Ngiru, fifteen miles from Narok. No layings were reported. On 29th November a thin swarm about four miles long and half a mile wide was seen four miles from Narok, but this swarm did no damage and no laying was observed. A large swarm was seen flying north from the Loita hills between Parkitabak and Narosura on 2nd December. Two small swarms were stated to be eighteen miles south of Kitui on 2nd December. These had arrived from the southeast. No damage was reported but a female locust collected from one of the swarms was examined by the Entomologist, who found that eggs were present in an almost fully developed condition, so that immediate laying is to be anticipated if this one specimen was representative of the swarm. Further specimens are being obtained for examination.

Nyanza Province.—No further reports have been received of locusts in this Province.

Rift Valley Province.—No locusts reported.

General.—No serious damage nor any laying has yet been reported, while no further mention has been made, by administrative and agricultural officers, of locusts in South Kavirondo.

Tanganyika.

The only reports of locusts in Tanganyika received since the previous report was issued on 19th November, stated that a small swarm of red locusts was present at Magrotto in the Usambaras; otherwise there was nothing to report.

Uganda.

It is stated in the Uganda Locust Report for October that a few swarms of the red locust continued to infest the Ankole district and caused some further damage to bananas, millet and maize crops, and to eucalyptus trees. No egg-laying had been observed, but small layings were expected to occur in November. Reports from other districts were negative.

AUCTION OF FARMS.

In default of such payment, the farm may be immediately re-offered for sale, and any subsequent bid by the person who has made default may be ignored or refused.
- 6. The balance of the purchase money in respect of Farms L.R. Nos. 3632, 826/1 and 2, 2924, 4424/13/1 and 2, 4424/14/1 and 2, and 3353 shall be paid in full to the Provincial Commissioner, Rift Valley Province, Box 81, Nakuru; and in respect of

- Farms L.R. Nos. 1225/10, 1225/11, 1225/12, 4428/10, 4428/11, 278, 4937, 299/R, 7197 and 2812 to the Land Assistant, Box 424, Nairobi, on or before the 1st April, 1936, or shall be paid in nine equal annual instalments, payable on the 1st day of January in each year, the first instalment being payable on the 1st January, 1937, and the purchaser shall inform the Provincial Commissioner, Nakuru, or the Land Assistant, Nairobi, as the case may require, on or before the 1st April, 1936, which method of payment he desires to adopt.
