The following is the text of the Proclamation made this day at Nairobi by His Excellency the Governor:

"Callereas it hath pleased ALMIGHTY GOD to call to His Mercy our Late Sovereign Lord KING GEORGE THE FIFTH of Blessed and Glorious Memory by whose Decease the Imperial Crown of Great Britain, Ireland, and all the other, His Late Majesty's, Dominions, is solely and rightfully come to the High and Mighty PRINCE EDWARD ALBERT CHRISTIAN GEORGE ANDREW PATRICK DAVID,

We, Joseph Aloysius Byrne (Governor in and over the Colony of Kenya), and We (being Members of the Executive Council of the Colony of Kenya)—

therefore, do now hereby with one Voice and Consent of Tongue and Heart, publish and proclaim that the High and Mighty PRINCE EDWARD ALBERT CHRISTIAN GEORGE ANDREW PATRICK DAVID is now, by the Death of Our Late Sovereign of Happy Memory, become Our only Lawful and Rightful Liege Lord EDWARD THE EIGHTH, by the GRACE OF GOD, of Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Dominions beyond the Seas, KING, Defender of the Faith, EMPEROR of India.

To whom we do acknowledge all Faith and Constant Obedience, with all hearty and humble Affection; beseeching God, by whom Kings and Queens do reign, to bless the Royal PRINCE EDWARD THE EIGHTH with long and happy years to reign over us.

GOD SAVE THE KING."
