- 1 The Government or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon the plot and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes, telegraph or telephone wires, and electric mains of all descriptions, whether overhead or underground, and the grantee shall not erect any building in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing routes, main or service pipes or the telegraph or telephone wires and electric mains aforementioned

THE RED LOCUST

Kenya

No reports of locusts in the Colony have been received during the past month, except from Kitui Egg laying was stated to have occurred at a point 12 miles to the south of Kitui on December 18th The natives in the area, under the direction of their headman, dug up the egg masses and exposed them to the sun. This work was completed by the beginning of January, and no further reports of adult locusts have been received. The swarms of locusts referred to in the Locust Report of December 13th as being near Kitui were stated, on January 4th, to have been completely destroyed by birds.

General —The Colony now seems clear of locust swarms, and it is not proposed to issue any further reports

Tanganyika

An occasional small swarm has been reported trom the northern and western borders of the Territory, otherwise the country appears to be free of locusts

Uganda

The November Report, issued on December 20th, stated that no locusts were observed in any district. The swarms previously present in Ankole appeared to have been dispersed by rainy conditions and there was no indication that the swarms had reformed
