ROYAL WARRANT

GEORGE, R I

GEORGE THE SIXTH, by the Grace of God, of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India, and Sovereign of the Distinguished Service Order, to all to whom these Presents shall come, greeting,

Whereas His late Majesty King George V by Warrants under His Royal Sign Manual dated the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen and the fifth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one did Make, Ordain, and Establish Statutes and Ordinances for the governance of the Distinguished Service Order, reserving to Himself, His Heirs and Successors, full power of annulling, altering, abrogating, augmenting, interpreting, or d'spensing with those Statutes or any part thereof under Royal Sign Manual,

And whereas by the said Royal Warrant dated the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen it was, among other things, ordained that the Badge of the Order should have on the reverse, the Royal Cypher,

And whereas We have thought fit to signify Our Royal Will and Pleasure that the Badge of the Order shall have on the reverse the Royal and Imperial Cypher,

Now therefore We do by these Presents for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, ordain and appoint that the Eleventh Clause of Our said Statutes shall be cancelled and annulled and the following substituted therefor —

Eleventhly It is ordained that the Badge of the Order shall consist of a gold cross, enamelled white, edged gold, having on one side thereof in the centre, within a wreath, a laurel enamelled green, the Imperial Crown in gold upon a red enamelled ground and on the reverse, within a similar wreath, and on a similar red ground, the Royal and Imperial Cypher, and shall be suspended from the left breast by a red riband, edged blue, of one inch in width

Given at Our Court of St James's, this 11th day of January in the Second Year of Our Reign in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight
