SUPPLEMENT

KENYA PROCLAMATIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS, No 38

Section 47 of the Principal Ordinance which it is proposed to amend —

Punishments
which officers
commanding
detachments,
etc., may award

47 Any officer commanding a detachment, or the administrative officer resident at and in charge of any station where there is a detachment but no officer of the regiment, may examine into the truth of any charge against a soldier or follower, and if his decision is against the accused, he may impose on him any one or more of the following punishments —

- (1) If a soldier not being a non-commissioned officer, save in the case of absence without leave or of drunkenness —
 - (a) Imprisonment for any period not exceeding fourteen days
 - (b) Fine not exceeding ten days' pay, to be levied by stoppages from the offender's pay
 - (c) Confinement to barracks for any period not exceeding twenty-one days, such confinement involving the taking of all duties in regular turn, attending parades and punishment drills, not exceeding one hour at a time, nor four hours

A Bill to Amend the King's African Rifles Ordinance, 1932

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the King's African Rifles (Amendment No 2) Ordinance, 1938, and shall be read as one with the King's African Rifles Ordinance, 1932, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and shall come into force on such date as the Governor may by notice in the Gazette appoint

Short title and commencement
No 48 of 1932

2 Section 47 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the first seven lines thereof and by substituting therefor the following —

Amendment of section 47 of the Principal Ordinance

“47 (1) Any officer, or British warrant officer, in command of a detachment, or the administrative officer resident at and in charge of any station where there is a detachment but where there is no officer or British warrant officer in command of such detachment, may examine into the truth of any charge against a soldier or follower, and if his decision is against the accused, he may impose on him any one or more of the following punishments —”

Punishments which officers commanding detachments, etc., may award

in all on the same day, exclusive of ordinary parades, and also liability to employment on duties of fatigue

(d) In addition to or without any other punishment, deduction from ordinary pay to make good the amount of any loss or damage he may have caused

(e) Extra guards and piquets, but only for minor offences or irregularities when on or parading for guard or piquet

(2) If a non-commissioned officer —

(a) Fine not exceeding ten days' pay to be levied by stoppages from the offender's pay

(b) Reprimand

(c) Deduction from his ordinary pay to make good the amount of any loss or damage he may have caused

(3) If a follower —

(a) Imprisonment for any period not exceeding fourteen days

(b) Fine not exceeding ten shillings

(4) (A) The offence of drunkenness by a soldier may be dealt with and summarily punished, as laid down in section 46 (1) (C) and section 46 (2) (C) of this Ordinance, by such officer or administrative officer

(B) In the case of absence without leave, the soldier may be dealt with as laid down in section 46 (1) (B) and section 46 (2) (B)

Section 63 of the Principal Ordinance which it is proposed to amend —

Organization

63 (1) A battalion shall consist of an officer with the rank of major in command and such other officers, British warrant and non-commissioned officers, locally enlisted British warrant and non-commissioned officers, non-commissioned officers and soldiers, as the Governor, subject to the approval of the Secretary of State, shall from time to time determine

(2) Officers shall be appointed by the Secretary of State

(3) Officers, British warrant and non-commissioned officers, locally enlisted British warrant and non-commissioned

3 Section 63 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

section 63 of
the Principal
Ordinance

- (a) by substituting the word “lieutenant-colonel” for the word “major” which occurs in the second line of sub-section (1) thereof,
- (b) by substituting a colon for the full stop which occurs at the end of sub-section (1) thereof, and by adding immediately after such colon the words—

“Provided that a cadre battalion shall be in command of an officer with the rank of major”, and

officers, non-commissioned officers and soldiers shall receive such rates of pay as the Governor, subject to the approval of the Secretary of State shall determine

(4) The officers, British warrant and non-commissioned officers, locally enlisted British warrant and non-commissioned officers, non-commissioned officers and soldiers of the battalion shall stand with each other in order of precedence and command as they have been here named

(5) The Governor may from time to time fill up all vacancies that may occur amongst the native ranks from removal, death, absence, incapacity, or other cause, by promotion or fresh appointments, and may at any time enlist fit men as soldiers of the regiment, and every such enlistment shall be an appointment under this Ordinance

Section 79 of the Principal Ordinance which it is proposed to amend —

Discharge on
completion of
service

79 Subject to the provisions of section 75 and of the last preceding section, every locally enlisted British warrant or non-commissioned officer or soldier who has completed his period or periods of engagement or service according to the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be discharged by his commanding officer, unless at the expiration of any period he is undergoing punishment for, or stands charged with, the commission of any offence under this Ordinance, and in case he is undergoing such punishment, or is charged with any such offence, his service shall be prolonged and his discharge deferred until such punishment shall have terminated, or until he has undergone his trial and any punishment awarded in respect of the offence with which he is charged, unless his sentence carries with it dismissal from the regiment

- (c) by deleting therefrom the comma which occurs in the second line of sub-section (4) thereof and substituting therefor the word "and"

4 Section 79 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the comma and words ", unless his sentence carries with it dismissal from the regiment" which occur in the thirteenth and fourteenth lines thereof and substituting therefor a colon and adding immediately after such colon the following proviso —

"Provided that if his sentence carries with it dismissal from the regiment he shall not be discharged but if he is awarded imprisonment his dismissal shall be deferred and shall not take effect until such imprisonment shall have terminated"

(a) by substituting the word "carriers" for the words "machine and Lewis gun porter" or "machine gun and Lewis gun porter", as the case may be, wherever either of such last-mentioned words occur therein, and

(b) by substituting the word "carriers" for the words "machine and Lewis gun porters" or "machine gun and Lewis gun porters", as the case may be, wherever either of such last-mentioned words occur therein

OBJECTS AND REASONS

Clause 2 of the Bill is designed to authorize a warrant officer to punish men under his command when he is a detachment commander. This is considered necessary as the new establishment for the King's African Rifles contains an increased number of warrant officers, who will be placed in charge of detachments at various times.

Clause 3 (a) and (b) allows for the new establishment under which the rifle battalions are commanded by Lieutenant-Colonels, and the cadre battalion by a Major.

Clause 3 (c) puts locally enlisted British warrant and non-commissioned officers on the same footing with regard to precedence as British warrant and non-commissioned officers. Under the existing law a British non-commissioned officer has precedence over a locally enlisted British warrant officer.

Clause 4 is designed to ensure that a civilian shall not be detained in a military guard room. It is frequently convenient for a sentence of imprisonment to be carried out in a unit guard room.

Clause 5 (a) and (b) deals with a change in nomenclature consequent upon the reorganization of the King's African Rifles.

No expenditure of public moneys will be involved if the provisions of this Bill become law.

LOCUST REPORTI—THE AFRICAN MIGRATORY LOCUST (*Locusta migratoria migratorioides*)*The situation in Kenya on 1st October, 1938*

Several swarms were reported on 15th September to be in the Meru-Nanyuki region, but since that date only one report of a swarm in that region has been received. That report was of a swarm at Timau on 20th September. Swarms left the Meru-Nanyuki region and moved in a south-westerly direction through the Fort Hall and Kiambu Districts (where they were reported on dates approximately between 14th and 24th September) and passed on to the Narok District. A swarm was reported near Karatina flying in the direction of Mount Kenya on 30th September. On 21st September a swarm was reported from Weiker in the Narok District, it moved north, along the foot of the Mau. Other small swarms were reported to be flying in a northerly direction near Suswa. The last report received from the Narok District was dated 23rd September and was to the effect that the Weiker swarm had turned south.

Swarms were reported in the Kerio Valley, which is south of the original main line of entry of locusts from the Karamoja. On the 13th September a swarm crossed the Valley from Kamasia to Elgeyo. A small swarm left the Kerio Valley in the direction of Kipkabus on the 14th instant and two other swarms left in the direction of Eldama Ravine on the 14th and 15th. By the 17th it was thought that no locusts were left in the Kerio Valley.

A swarm, which had apparently proceeded round the west side of Mount Elgon through the Eastern Province of Uganda and had not taken the easterly route taken by the majority of swarms, penetrated the North Kavirondo District from near Tororo on the 10th September and proceeded through Malakisi in a north-easterly direction to Kimilili on the 13th instant. It then returned westwards to Wamia and on the 14th instant either that swarm or another swarm from Wamia proceeded in an easterly direction along the railway line through Sangalo and Broderick Falls to Kabras and North Wanga and on to Kakamega. On the 17th September it was stated that the whole of the North Kavirondo District, north of Kakamega, appeared to be infested. Fortunately most, but not all, crops had been harvested, but locusts were said to be eating young new season's crops. On the 23rd September these locusts had reached the northern boundary of the Central Kavirondo District, in the vicinity of Yala. A large swarm reported at Yala split in two, one portion moved in a south-westerly direction reaching Asembo and Sakwa on the 29th instant, the other portion moved in a south-easterly direction across the Kano Plains, missing the Miwani sugar plantations and reached the Belgut Reserve (South Lumbwa District) on the 27th instant. Locusts were reported from Location 2, Kipsigis Reserve, on 30th September. The swarm reported to have reached the neighbourhood of Kipkabus from Elgeyo on the 27th may have joined up in North Kavirondo District with the swarm from Uganda reported above.

No reports have been received which indicate that any fresh swarms of locusts came to Kenya from the Karamoja since the publication of the last report, but, as stated above, African migratory locusts entered North Kavirondo from the Eastern Province of Uganda.

No reports of egg-laying have been received to date and the Entomologist in charge reports that, from the examination of all specimens received, egg development is no further advanced than it was at the time of the last report, dated 15th September.

*Reports from other Territories**Uganda Report for August, 1938*

"A considerable influx of this species from the north occurred during the month. The first swarm entered Karamoja on August 3rd from Turkana, this had reached the vicinity of Ngora (Teso) at the end of the month. Another swarm entered Chua on August 4th from the Sudan. Further swarms came south through Madi and Gulu districts, one reaching the vicinity of Lake Kyoga in Lango. In West Nile, the surviving hoppers attained the winged stage and a few thin swarms were recorded flying aimlessly about the district.

Infestation by *nematode* worms caused death of a small proportion of fliers in Teso.

Damage to *Eleusine* millet in Acholi district was intense locally. 227 plots were destroyed in Chua, 735 plots damaged in Gulu, while in Madi 100 plots destroyed and others affected in less degree."

II—THE RED LOCUST (*Nomadacris septemfasciata*)
The Situation in Kenya on 1st October, 1938

As far as is known the Colony still remains free from swarms of this species.

*Reports from other Territories**Uganda Report for August, 1938*

"A further reduction of hoppers was effected by the local inhabitants in the eastern area. At the end of the month a few of the survivors were about to enter the winged stage. Some of the hoppers in Teso were noted to be dying from disease. No flights of red locusts were recorded in this area. Negligible damage was caused to crops in Busoga and Bugwere, while somewhat more intense damage was caused to cotton in Teso and to cotton and beans in Budama District.

In the western area activity of flying swarms continued on much the same scale as during July, the records totalling five in western Toro, three in western Ankole and six in Kigezi. In the last-named district the swarms were stated to be very small. Some intense damage was caused to *Eleusine* millet in Toro."
