His Excellency the Governor in Council has approved of the following Bill being introduced into the Legislative Council.

A Bill to Provide for the Supply of a Further Sum of Money for the Service of the Year Ended 31st December, 1940.

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

Public revenue charged.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the 1940 Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance, 1941.

2. The public revenue for the period 1st January to 31st December, 1940, of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya is hereby charged towards the service of the period 5 1st January to 31st December, 1940, with a further sum of five hundred and fifty-three thousand six hundred and twelve pounds, fourteen shillings and ninety-two cents in addition to the sums provided by the 1940 Appropriation Ordinance, 1939.

Accountant General's authority for payment.

3. The money granted by this Ordinance shall be applied to the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule hereto.

4. The Accountant General of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya is hereby given authority for having paid 15 out of the revenue of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya, for the several services specified in the Schedule hereto the said sum of five hundred and fifty-three thousand six hundred and twelve pounds, fourteen shillings and ninety-two cents which have come in course of payment during the period 20 1st January to 31st December, 1940.

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GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 816

NOTICE

IT IS notified for general information that a review of the working of the Defence (No Treating) Regulations, 1940, has revealed that the observance of these Regulations has not received that support on the part of the general public, which it was always recognized would be necessary were they to prove fully effective, and which at the time of their enactment it was hoped they would receive.

The Government has therefore decided to revoke these Regulations and instead to curtail the period during which alcoholic liquor may be sold, supplied, bought or consumed, on licensed premises, including clubs, by the enactment of the Defence Regulations published as Government Notice No. 822 in the Official Gazette Supplement on 7th October, 1941.

With effect from the 15th of October the revised hours of sale will be from 11.30 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. and from 6.00 p.m. to 10.15 p.m. in the Coast Province, and elsewhere in the Colony from 12.00 noon to 2.30 p.m. and from 6.00 p.m. to 10.15 p.m. District Commissioners are empowered to grant a temporary extension licence authorizing the sale of liquor on the licensed premises specified in such temporary licence in respect of any Saturday and one other day in the week between the hours of 10.15 p.m. and midnight. A relaxation of the Regulations may be authorized in the case of special functions.

The preceding paragraph summarizes only a few of the Regulations; all the Regulations must be read before their full scope can be appreciated.

By arrangement with the General Officer Commanding in Chief the sale of alcoholic liquors at military bars and canteens will be restricted to the same hours.

INOCULATION AGAINST YELLOW FEVER

PUBLIC NOTICE

TO PERSONS contemplating travelling from Kenya by air services to any other part of Africa or to India, or by air, ship, rail or motor car from Kenya to Uganda, the Belgian Congo, or the Sudan, or from Kenya (or from Uganda via Kenya) by ship to India; and to persons contemplating travelling to, or returning to, Kenya from "yellow fever infected areas".

The restrictions which are at present placed on persons travelling through or from "yellow fever infected areas" in Africa by the Governments of Kenya, Uganda, and the Anglo-Egyptian Sudan, and by the Government of India with a view to preventing the spread of yellow fever may, in so far as they affect persons travelling from, to, or through Kenya, be summarized as follows:—

INDIA.—Under the Indian Aircraft (Public Health) Rules, 1940, no person travelling by air who within the preceding nine days has been resident in, or has passed through a "yellow fever infected area" may land in India unless he or she has been inoculated against yellow fever not less than 23 days, nor longer than two years, before arriving in India, and in the said regulations Uganda, the Southern Sudan, and the Belgian Congo, all West African Territories, and Abyssinia, are classified as "yellow fever infected areas".

UGANDA.—Under a Proclamation dated the 27th of May, 1941, no person may enter Uganda from the Belgian Congo either by aeroplane, motor car, lorry, or on foot, unless he or she has been inoculated against yellow fever at least 14 days before leaving the Belgian Congo.

SUDAN.—Under the Sudan Quarantine (Aircraft) Amendment Regulations, 1941, no person resident in the Southern Sudan may leave the Southern Sudan by air for any destination abroad unless he or she has been inoculated against yellow fever not less than 20 days beforehand, or unless, before so leaving, he or she has been detained for ten days in quarantine on an anti-amaryl (anti-yellow fever) aerodrome; and, under the Sudan Public Health (Yellow Fever) Regulations, 1941, no person who has been resident in the Southern Sudan within the preceding ten days may depart from the Sudan at Wadihalfa by air or car, or from any Red Sea port in the Sudan by ship within ten days of leaving the Southern Sudan, unless he or she has been inoculated against yellow fever The effect of the Regulations which are summarized above, in so far as they may concern travellers from or to Kenya, to or from any of the countries mentioned is that such travellers, unless they are in possession of satisfactory evidence that they have been inoculated against yellow fever at least fourteen days before leaving, or arriving in Kenya, may at certain points experience difficulty in proceeding on their journey, or in securing entry, or re-entry into Kenya.

If, however, a traveller from or to Kenya has been inoculated against yellow fever fourteen days before leaving or arriving in Kenya and carries his inoculation certificate with him or her, he or she should nowhere experience any difficulties on account of quarantine regulations at any point in his or her journey.

Persons who are likely to have occasion to travel from Kenya by air to any other part of Africa, or by car to the Belgian Congo or the Sudan, or from or through the Belgian Congo, or the Sudan to Kenya, are therefore most strongly advised to be inoculated at least fourteen days before leaving or arriving in Kenya in order to ensure that they may suffer no inconvenience or detention in quarantine en route to their destination, on arrival at their destination, or on their return to, or arrival in Kenya.

Furthermore, as cases of yellow fever have lately occurred in Western Uganda, and as any occurrence of cases of yellow fever farther to the east in Uganda might render it necessary for the Government of Kenya to impose restrictions on persons travelling from Kenya to Uganda, or from Uganda to Kenya, or for either the Government of Kenya or the Government of India to impose restrictions on persons originating in, or travelling through Kenya, and embarking at Mombasa for India, any persons contemplating travelling from Kenya to Uganda, or vice versa, or from or through Kenya to India by ship are also advised to be inoculated against yellow fever now.

Facilities for the inoculation of the public against yellow fever are available as follows:—

- NAIROBI.—At the Municipal Health Office, Town Hall, City Square, from 10 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays.
- MOMBASA.—At the Municipal Health Office from 9 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays.
- NAKURU, ELDORET AND KISUMU.—By arrangement with the Medical Officer of Health at each of these towns.

UGANDA.—At most Government Medical Stations.

at least 20 days prior to the day on which such person proposes to leave either Wadihalfa or a Red Sea port in the Sudan.

KENYA.—Any passenger arriving in Kenya by aeroplane from the Belgian Congo (whether originating in or having been in transit through the Belgian Congo, and whether destined for, or in transit through Kenya) who within the preceding six days has been in any part of the Belgian Congo north of Lat. 10°S., or arriving by aeroplane from the Southern Sudan, having been resident there within the preceding six days in any place other than an anti-amaryl (anti-yellow fever) aerodrome, or who within six days of arrival in Kenya has been in or landed in any West African Territory, will be liable to be detained in quarantine on arrival in Kenya, unless he or she be in possession of a certificate from a duly authorized medical officer to the effect that the said passenger has been inoculated against yellow fever at least 14 days before arriving in Kenya.

NOTES

(i) Inoculation against yellow fever is not unpleasant, and, in the great majority of instances, is not followed by even the slightest noticeable reaction. Over 100,000 persons have already been so inoculated in Kenya, and many more in Uganda.

(ii) The certificates of inoculation which are issued should be regarded as valuable and important documents which should be carefully preserved, and these certificates should always be carried when travelling outside of Kenya.

(iii) Inoculation against yellow fever confers immunity against yellow fever for at least two years, and very probably for a much longer period.

(iv) The rules and regulations which have been quoted in this notice, in so far as entry, or re-entry to the Colony of Kenya may be concerned, apply to all travellers, whether civilian or military.

Such plans, etc., shall be submitted in triplicate to the Town Clerk, Nairobi, for necessary action. 3. Grants will be subject to the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance and titles will be issued under the Registration of Titles Ordinance. The term of the grants will be 99 years from the 1st day of November, 1941.

4. The grantee shall not at any time divide the plot without the permission of the Commissioner of Lands.


