### ABERDARE DISTRICT COUNCIL

Notice under Section 22 of the Resident Labourers ORDINANCE, 1937

NOTICE is hereby given that the Aberdare District Council proposes to amend its Resident Labourers (Aberdare District) Order, 1944, issued under Government Notice No. 666 of 3rd August, 1944

The general purport of the Order is as follows:-

- 1. To prohibit the engagement of any resident labourers in the Aberdare District Council district except under permit issued by the Aberdare District Council.
- 2. To limit the number of resident labourers residing on any farm for which a permit has been obtained, to the number allowed in such permit.
- 3. To prescribe that the minimum number of days in a year which all resident labourers shall be required to work shall be 270.
- 4. To prohibit the keeping of cattle and pigs.
- 5. To limit the number of stock kept by any one resident labourer to 15 sheep and two donkeys, or on application, to 15 goats in place of 15 sheep, or in special circumstances, a mixed flock of not more than 15 sheep and goats.
- 6. To limit the area of land to be cultivated by any one resident labourer for his own or his family's use to one acre for every adult member of his family who is working for the occupier, subject to a maximum of three acres per family
- It is proposed that, if the Order is finally approved by His Excellency the Governor in Council, it shall become effective as from 31st March, 1945.

A copy of the proposed Order is deposited at the office of the Aberdare District Council, Nanyuki, and at the District Commissioners' offices and police stations in the district, and is open to inspection by any person during the usual office hours.

Any objections to the proposed Order should be lodged in writing with the Engineer-Clerk to the Aberdare District Council, Nanyuki, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.

IT IS hereby notified for information that the Nairobi District Council proposes to make the following order under the Resident Labourers Ordinance, 1937, and the Resident Labourers (Amendment) Ordinance, 1941:-

### ORDER

### BY THE NAIROBI DISTRICT COUNCIL

- IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Nairobi District Council (hereinafter called the Council) by section 21 of the Resident Labourers Ordinance, 1937, and the Resident Labourers (Amendment) Ordinance, 1941, the Council hereby orders as follows:-
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Resident Labourers (Nairobi District Council) Order, 1945, and shall apply to all farms situate within the jurisdiction of the Council, and shall cancel and revoke the Nairobi District Council (Resident Labourers) Order, 1943, as published in Government Notice No. 1069 of the Official Gazette dated 21st December, 1943.
- 2. (1) Any occupier of a farm, or group of contiguous farms under the same ownership, may apply to the Council in the form set forth in the First Schedule hereto for a permit to engage resident labourers.
- (2) No native or Somali shall be engaged as a resident labourer, and no resident labourer shall continue to reside on any farm except in accordance with a permit issued to the occupier by the Council in the form set forth in the Second Schedule hereto.
- (3) The said permit shall be valid for a period of three years and shall be subject to the condition that it may be cancelled upon the Council giving not less than six months notice in writing to the holder thereof.
- (4) Application for a permit shall be made to the Clerk to the Council from whom the application form shall be obtainable, and the applicant shall pay a fee of five shillings for the permit, or for any duplicate thereof.
- 3. (1) After the date of the publication of confirmation of this Order by His Excellency the Governor in Council the number of resident labourers engaged on any one farm shall be limited in accordance with the number stated in the permit for that farm.
- (2) The granting of, or the cancelling of, any permits for any farms, shall be at the discretion of the Council which in exercising such discretion will take into consideration whether there is sufficient European occupancy to ensure the proper control of the resident labourers engaged on such farm.
- (3) The Council in deciding the number of resident labourers allowed by any permit shall have regard to the scale set forth in the Third Schedule hereto.
- 4. (1) An occupier desiring to have a contract attested shall mark the contract and each copy thereof with the number of his permit, and with the appropriate serial number and fill in in columns I, II and III in page 2 of his permit the particulars required of the proposed contract and shall send the contract, together with his permit, to the attesting officer, for attestation.
- (2) When any contract is terminated the employer shall enter the date of the termination of such contract in column VI on page 2 of the permit, and sign in column VII as certifying that such contract has been terminated.
- 5. (1) An attesting officer, or magistrate, when attesting a contract under this Order, shall ensure—
- (a) that the contract is marked with the permit number and its appropriate serial number;
- (b) that the proposed contract is for the farm for which the permit is issued;
- (c) that the proposed contract will not increase the number of resident labourers so as to exceed the number allowed by that permit, as disclosed on page 2 of the permit.
- (2) If the attesting officer or magistrate is satisfied that the contract is in order, he shall insert the date in column IV of the permit and sign or stamp the permit in column V thereof.
- (3) If for any reason he does not attest the proposed contract he shall write "cancelled" in column VI and sign in column VII of the permit.
- 6. After the date of the publication of confirmation of this Order by His Excellency the Governor in Council, the Council, in deciding the number of resident labourers allowed by any permit shall have regard to the scale set forth in the Third Schedule hereto.
- 7. After the date of the publication of confirmation of this Order by His Excellency the Governor in Council:-
- (1) The minimum number of days in a year on which a resident labourer shall work and for which he shall receive wages shall be two hundred and forty.
- (2) No resident labourer shall reside, or shall keep any stock, on any unoccupied or undeveloped farm, save with the permission in writing of the Clerk to the Council.
- (3) The keeping on any farm of cattle, sheep or goats by resident labourers in excess of one head of cattle or five head of sheep or five head of goats to five acres of grazing is pro-
- (4) (a) No resident labourer shall keep any cattle or goats in the Limuru Ward.

- (b) No resident labourer shall keep any goats-
- (i) in that portion of the Kiambu Ward which lies to the west of the Fort Hall Road; and
- (ii) in the Kikuyu-Kabete-Ngong Ward.
- (c) No resident labourer shall keep stock of any description whatsoever in the Ngong section of the Kikuyu-Kabete-Ngong Ward.
- (d) No resident labourer shall reside in that portion of the Kiambu Ward which is bounded on the north-west by the Fort Hall Road, on the south and south-east by the Nairobi Municipal boundary and the Gethathuru River, on the east and northeast by the westerly boundaries of Plot No. L.R. 31 and L.R. 1012/40 with the Fort Hall Road.
- (5) No resident labourer shall, subject to the specific prohibitions of section 7 hereof, after the coming into force of this Order, bring on to any farm, or at any time during the continuance of this Order, keep on any farm, more than ten head of cattle and ten head of sheep or ten goats in place of ten sheep.
- (6) No resident labourer shall keep a pig or pigs, within the area of jurisdiction of the Council.
- (7) The acreage that may be cultivated by a resident labourer shall be left to the discretion of the occupier.
- A copy of the proposed Order is deposited at the entrance to the Offices of Council, Victoria Street, Nairobi, for inspection by any person.
- Any objection to the proposed Order shall be lodged with the undersigned within twenty-eight days of the date of publication of this notice.
