OBITUARY

He was a hard-working, keen officer whose practical articles in the East African Agricultural Journal have been of great help to many farmers and whose bent for carrying out trials and experiments has been of real value to the country.

By his death the Government has lost a highly efficient and loyal officer who never spared himself in the public service. Captain Elmer is survived by his widow, a son and daughter to whom the sincere sympathy of the Government, and particularly of the members of the Agricultural Department, is extended.
