REVISED DEFINITION OF VALUE OF GOODS SUBJECT TO AD VALOREM DUTIES

THE attention of importers is drawn to the Customs Tariff (Amendment) Ordinance, 1945, which will come into operation on 1st April, 1945. The amendment to section 4 of the principal Ordinance has the effect of changing the definition of value which forms the basis for the assessment of ad valorem duties.

Briefly, the change in procedure no longer requires the current domestic value in the country of dispatch for the purpose of assessing value but it requires that the dutiable 'alue shall be in effect the landed value at Mombasa on a basis that the transaction for the purchase of the goods had been concluded between the buyer and the seller with one consider tion only, namely the price of goods to an ordinary purchair in the Colony; this price to include freight, insurance and other expenses up to the point of landing.
