**A Bill to Allow and Confirm Certain Expenditure Incurred  
in the Financial Year 1944**

WHEREAS the amount of seven million six hundred and eighty-nine thousand two hundred and sixty-four pounds, ten shillings and seventy-nine cents was necessarily incurred during the Financial Year 1944 on certain services, of which the sum of five million eight hundred and sixty thousand two hundred and ten pounds has been provided by the 1944 Appropriation Ordinance, 1943, and it is now requisite to make a further provision of one million eight hundred and twenty-nine thousand and fifty-four pounds, ten shillings and seventy-nine cents:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1944) Ordinance, 1945.

Further expenditure for the Financial Year 1944 authorized. 2. The expenditure during the Financial Year 1944 to the amount of one million eight hundred and twenty-nine thousand and fifty-four pounds, ten shillings and seventy-nine cents on the several services specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance and not provided for or not fully provided for by the 1944 Appropriation Ordinance, 1943, is hereby allowed and confirmed.

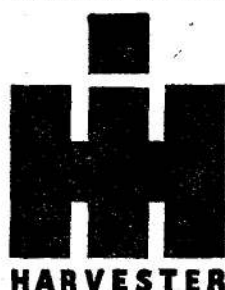
