AFRICAN SETTLEMENT BOARD

APPOINTMENT OF BOARD

IT IS notified for general information that the Member for Agriculture and Natural Resources has appointed, in accordance with paragraph 18 (a) of Sessional Paper No. 8 of 1945, an African Settlement Board with the following terms of reference:—

In collaboration with the Administration:—

(1) To ascertain in what areas over-population and overstocking most urgently necessitate measures for the resettlement of Africans.

(2) To investigate and ascertain which areas of Crown land outside the Highlands are suitable for African settlement.

(3) To investigate likely areas in Native Land Units with a view to determining whether they are suitable for re-settlement or closer settlement of Africans.

(4) To prepare, for submission to the Central Settlement Board, detailed schemes for settlement of natives in suitable areas of Crown land outside the Highlands, and for betterment areas and/or re-settlement schemes in Native Land Units.

(5) To prepare, for submission to the Native Lands Trust Board, schemes for proper land utilization not only in the areas mentioned in (4) above but also in the areas from which natives are moved in order to prevent the further deterioration of such areas and with the aim of the proper and efficient development of such areas.

(6) In preparing the schemes referred to above to recommend the conditions to be observed in relation to the particular use of land such as soil conservation measures, grazing control, etc.

TRANS NZOIA DISTRICT COUNCIL

THE RESIDENT LABOURERS ORDINANCE

NOTICE is hereby given that His Excellency the Governor in Council has confirmed the Resident Labourers (Trans Nzoia District) (Amendment) Order, 1945.

This amending Order comes into operation on the 1st January, 1946.

The only alteration in the original Order effected by this amending Order is that the maximum number of cattle allowed any one resident labourer is reduced from ten to five.

Under section 21 (3) of the Resident Labourers Ordinance it is incumbent on all employers of resident labourers in the Trans Nzoia District, within one month of the coming into operation of this amending order, either (a) to arrange with all their resident labourers whose contracts allow for more than five head of cattle, to have such contracts altered so that they comply with the amending Order in respect of the number of head of cattle; or (b) failing such an arrangement, to give the resident labourers in question three months notice of termination of their contract.

Employers are reminded that the amendment of a resident labourer's contract requires the approval of an attesting officer. As this may mean that a considerable number of resident labourers will have to be sent, with their contracts, to an attesting officer, an endeavour will be made to arrange with the administration for attesting officers to be available in certain places in the district on certain stated days, for the purpose of attesting such amendments. If such arrangements are able to be made, a further notice will be published in the local Press.

GENERAL PRICE LEVEL—OCTOBER, 1945

THE general level of retail prices of consumers goods in Nairobi on 31st October, 1945, as measured by returns received from representative dealers, was 61.9 per cent above the pre-war level, while the corresponding figure for August, 1945, was 62.3 per cent. Imported articles were 73.1 per cent above the pre-war level and local products 52.7 per cent, while the corresponding figures for August, 1945, were 73.1 per cent and 53.5 per cent respectively.

Among local products the only considerable change was a decrease in the price of lake fish, which was seasonal.

CONTROL OF GRASS FIRES ORDINANCE, 1941

Order

IN EXERCISE of powers conferred by section 10 of the Control of Grass Fires Ordinance, 1941, the Nakuru District Council hereby declares a state of danger in respect of the Nakuru District Council area.

The burning of vegetation within the said Nakuru District Council area is hereby prohibited except as hereunder stated for a period of three months from 15th December, 1945, and anyone who burns vegetation contrary to the provisions of this Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Wards.—Rongai, Ravine, Njoro, Molo and Lower Molo from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Wards.—Bahati, Solai, Lake and Subukia from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m.

Burning at other times may be sanctioned by ward members in writing.

Armlets are available for issue to farmers on payment of Sh. 2 from Nakuru District Council for authorized Fire Rangers, who should be registered with the Nakuru District Council, and at present be unpaid.
