### A BILL TO APPLY CERTAIN SUMS OF MONEY FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING THE 31st DAY OF DECEMBER, 1947

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows—

Short t tle

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the 1947 Appropriation Ordinance, 1947

Public revenue and other funds charged 2. The public revenue for the year 1947 and other funds of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya are hereby charged towards the service of the year ending the thirty-5 first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven with the sum of seven million, seven hundred and ninety-nine thousand, six hundred and seventy pounds in respect of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya, and with the further sum of four million, four hundred and thirty-10 three thousand, five hundred and seventy-four pounds in respect of the Development and Reconstruction Fund

Application of moneys granted

3. The moneys granted by this Ordinance shall be applied for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedules hereto

Accountant General s authority for payment 4 The Accountant General of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya is hereby authorized and required from time to time upon the warrant or order of the Governor to pay out of the revenue and other funds of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya, for the several services specified in the 20 Schedules hereto, the said sum of seven million, seven hundred and ninety-nine thousand, six hundred and seventy pounds, and the said further sum of four million, four hundred and thirty-three thousand, five hundred and seventy-four pounds, which will come in course of payment during 25 the year ending the 31st day of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven






