WATER RESOURCES BOARD APPOINTMENT OF BOARD

IT IS notified for general information that the Government has decided to reorganize the authority and procedure which has governed for nearly 20 years the control, distribution and development of water supplies in Kenya In order to achieve this task, it has been decided to appoint a Water Resources Board This appointment will of necessity be of an interim nature in the first instance as legal provision for its constitution and operation will have to be made The interim terms of reference

(a) To investigate and promote the conservation of water, the provision of additional water supplies and the development of existing water supplies and to make recommendations to the Member for Agriculture and Natural

Resources (b) to advise the Member for Agriculture and Natural Resources as to the general policy to be followed in the distribution of water supplies in the Colony,

(c) to revise the existing legislation concerning water supplies and to propose from time to time such legislation as may be required in order that the Board may carry out its duties satisfactorily
