## KENYA GOVERNMENT OVERSEAS BURSARIES

APPLICATIONS for the Kenya Government (European), (Indian) and (Goan) Overseas Bursaries for 1947/48 should reach the Director of Education, P O Box 340, Nairobi not later than the 31st of March, 1947. In the case of candidates not resident in Kenya the closing date is the 15th March, 1947. It should be noted that applications received after the closing dates can in no circumstances be considered. Forms of application together with particulars regarding the conditions governing the award of bursaries, can be obtained from the Education Department.

Assistance will be limited to the children of parents domiciled in Kenya who have resided continuously in the Colony for a minimum period of ten years. Absence from the Colony for purpose of health or holidays will not be deemed to break continuous residence, provided that the total period of absence during the ten years does not exceed three years. Candidates for bursaries must have completed five years' continuous attendance at a school or schools in Kenya.

Applications will only be considered from candidates who are in possession of a matriculation certificate or its equivalent or who have taken the Cambridge School Certificate Examination or equivalent in December, 1946, and are awaiting the results.

Parents of present bursars are reminded that applications for renewals or extensions of existing bursaries should be made not later than the 31st March, 1947, and these should be accompanied by a financial statement which reflects the present financial circumstances of the parents.
