THE ELECTRIC POWER ORDINANCE

PUBLIC NOTICE of an application to be made for licences—

- (a) to authorize the generation of electrical energy from the existing hydro electric generating station on the Sagana River, and
- (b) to authorize the distribution and supply of electrical energy from such generating station within the Nyeri and Karatina Districts

Notice is hereby given to all whom it may concern that on the 20th day of May, 1947, the Postmaster General of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya will make application to His Excellency the Governor in Council for—

- (i) a distributing licence to authorize the distribution and supply of electrical energy for public and private purposes in the area hereinafter described, and
- (ii) for a local generating licence to generate electrical energy in the existing hydro-electric station at the Sagana Falls for the purposes of the aforesaid distributing licence

The area within which it is proposed that supplies of electrical energy shall be authorized is shown bordered blue on the plan marked "A" which has been deposited at the offices of the Provincial Commissioner, Nyeri, and the Government Electrical Engineer, Nairobi, and is bounded as follows—

Commencing at the junction of the Thego River with the Sagana River

thence down-stream by the latter river to its intersection with the Nairobi-Nanyuki railway line,

thence south easterly by that railway line to a point due north of the north-western corner of the Karatina Railway Station Reserve,

thence due east by a straight line for a distance of $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles,

thence due south by a straight line to a point due east of the trigonometrical station Tumu-tumu

thence by a straight line to that trigonometrical station,

thence by a straight line to the trigonometrical station Nyakagembe and onwards by the same straight line to its intersection with the boundary of the Aberdare Forest Reserve,

thence generally northerly by that boundary to its intersection with the Amboni River,

thence down-stream by that river to its intersection with the south-eastern boundary of L R No 1249

thence along the boundary between L R No 1249 and L R No 6376/R to the point of intersection of that boundary with the boundary between L R No 6376/R and I R No 1247/R,

thence along the boundary between L R No 1247/R and L R No 6376/R to its intersection with the generally western boundary of the Mount Kenya Forest Reserve,

thence generally south-easterly by part of that boundary to its intersection with the Sagana River,

thence by that river down stream to the point of commencement

The streets and roads along which it is proposed that electric supply lines shall be installed are shown—

(a) Main transmission lines on the plan marked 'A',

(b) distribution lines on the plan marked "B", which have been deposited at the offices of the Provincial Commissioner, Nyeri, and the Government Electrical Engineer Nairobi, and the proposed electric supply lines are delineated on the said plans by full red and green lines

The position of such electric supply lines however, may be varied to meet requirements in connexion with any proposed revision of town planning which may be contemplated in the Nyeri Township. In addition, distributing mains will be installed in streets in the Karatina Trading Centre to afford such supplies as may be required

Further distribution mains will be installed as may be required under the provisions of the Electric Power Ordinance

The public and private purposes of the licences will include all the supplies required for public, industrial and domestic power and public, industrial and domestic lighting and such other supplies as may be required. Supply will be made available to consumers throughout the 24 hours of the day

The generating station in which electrical energy is to be generated will consist of the existing hydro-electric power station comprising three generators each of a capacity of 120 kW situate at Sagana Falls, near Karatina, which has been used for the supply of electrical energy to the Dried Vegetable Factory, Karatina. The generating plant therein will be renewed or amplified as and when required

All works will be of the descriptions and types required by and will be carried out in accordance with the Electric Power Ordinance and the Rules thereunder

Copies of the drafts of the licences being applied for and of the licences when granted will be deposited at the offices of the Provincial Commissioner, Nyeri, and the Government Electrical Engineer, Nairobi

Any public or local authority, company person or body of persons, desirous of making any representation on or objection to the grant of the licences, or with respect to the proposed works, must do so by letter addressed to the Governor in Council and marked on the outside of the cover enclosing it "Electric Power Ordinance" on or before the expiration of 60 days from the date of the application as stated in this notice and must forward to the applicant a copy of such representation or objection

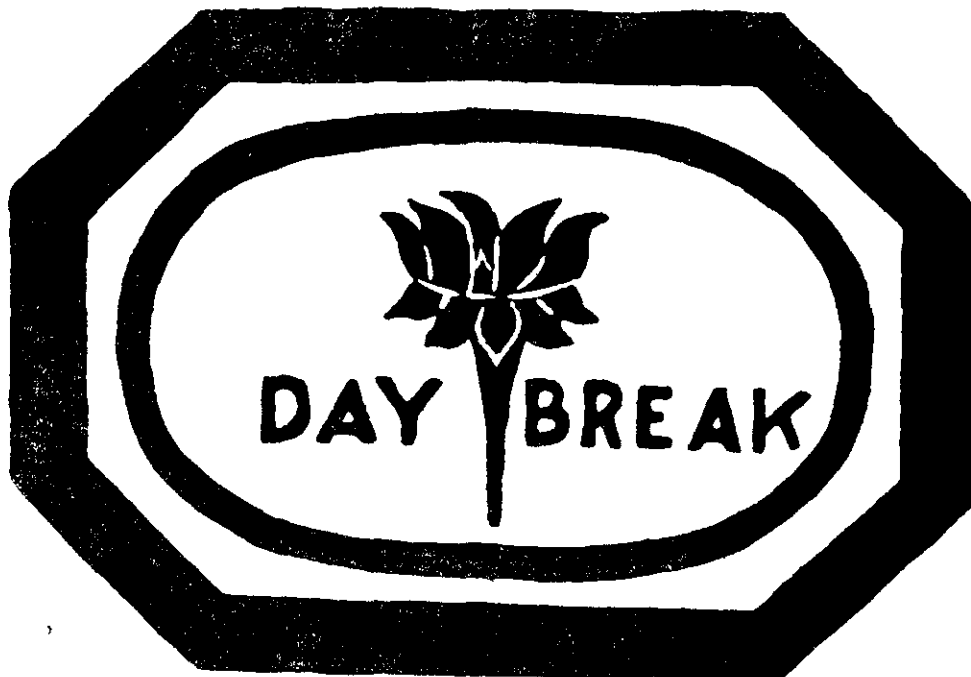
