A BILL TO AMEND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MUNICIPALITIES) ORDINANCE, 1928

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows—

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Government (Municipalities) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Local Government (Municipalities) Ordinance, 1928, hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance

No 19 of 1928

Amendment of section 69 of the principal Ordinance

- 2. Section 69 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (42) thereof and substituting therefor the following paragraph
 - "(42) For prohibiting or restricting, notwithstanding any provision of any law relating to traffic, the use of any 10 specified class of vehicle in the whole or any portion of the municipality,"

Addition of new section 88A to the principal Ordinance Borrowing

Ordinance
Borrowing
powers for
special purposes

- 3. The principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting therein, immediately after section 88 thereof the following new section
 - 88A (1) In addition to the powers of borrowing conferred upon the Council by section 88 of this Ordinance, the Council, by a majority of the Councillors present at a meeting specially convened for the purpose at which the majority voting shall not be less than a majority of 20 the whole Council may for the purpose of acquiring, establishing or constructing any property, whether movable or immovable, of a revenue-earning character raise by way of loan, from any person, sums of money of such amount, at such rates of interest and upon such 25 terms as to the repayment of the principal sum and upon such other conditions, as may be agreed upon between the Council and such person with the approval of the Governor in Council and of the Secretary of State

Security for such borrowings

(2) Any loan made to the Council under the provi- 30 sions of this section may be secured by a first mortgage or a first charge or by debentures upon the assets, and the revenues derived from such assets, in respect of which the money is borrowed but not upon any other assets or revenues of the Council The provisions of section 88 of 35 this Ordinance shall not apply to such loan or to any interest due thereon, and the assets, in respect of which such money is borrowed and upon which such money is secured by way of mortgage, charge or debenture, and the revenue derived from such assets, shall not be deemed 40 to be the property of the Council for the purposes of sub-section (3) of section 89 of this Ordinance, but the mortgagee, chargee or debenture holder may exercise all such legal and equitable remedies in respect of his mortgage, charge or debenture as may, from time to time, 45 be in force in the Colony"

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to amend the Local Government (Municipalities) Ordinance, 1928, in two respects

Clause 2—Under the law as it stands a Municipal Council or Board may, by By-law, prohibit or restrict the use of specified classes of vehicles in certain streets or areas within the Municipality, but there is no power to make a By-law prohibiting the use of a specified class of vehicles throughout the Municipality This Clause seeks to remedy this deficiency in the law

Clause 3—This Clause seeks to confer upon a Municipal Council or Board powers to raise money other than through Government sources, for the acquisition of movable or immovable property It is proposed that such loans shall be secured solely upon the assets established, acquired or constructed with the loan and upon the revenues derived from such assets

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be involved if the provisions of this Bill become law
