A BILL TO AMEND THE TEA ORDINANCE, 1934

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

Short title

No 46 of 1934

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tea (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Tea Ordinance, 1934, hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance

Repeal of section 3 (3) of the principal Ordinance

Repeal and replacement of section 15 of the principal Ordinance

- 2. Sub-section (3) of section 3 of the principal Ordinance 5 is hereby repealed
- 3. Section 15 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following section substituted therefor
 - "15 This Ordinance shall continue in force until the 31st day of March, 1948, and shall then expire Provided 10 that the Governor may by proclamation, with the approval of the Legislative Council, declare that this Ordinance shall remain in force until a date to be fixed in such proclamation"

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to achieve two objects—

- (a) to delete from the Tea Ordinance, 1934, the restriction on the number of acres which may be planted with tea in the Colony, and
- (b) to provide that the Ordinance, as amended shall remain in force until the 31st March, 1948, or until such other date as the Governor, with the approval of the Legislative Council, may declare

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be involved if the provisions of this Bill become law
