The terms of reference of the Board are to advise the Commissioner for African Land Utilization and Settlement as regards carrying out, in collaboration with the Administration, the

following duties which have been conferred upon him -

- (1) To ascertain in what areas over-population and overstocking most urgently necessitate measures for the resettlement of Africans, and to that end to collect the necessary data and information on which remedial measures can be based
- (2) To investigate and ascertain which areas of land outside the Highlands are suitable for African settlement
- (3) To investigate likely areas in Native Land Units with a view to determining whether they are suitable for resettlement or closer settlement of Africans
- (4) To prepare, for submission to the Member for Agiiculture and Natural Resources, detailed schemes for settlement of natives in suitable areas of land outside the Highlands, and for betterment areas and/or settlement schemes in Native Land Units
- (5) To prepare schemes for proper land utilization not only in the areas mentioned in (4) above but also in the areas from which natives are moved in older to prevent the further deterioration of such areas and with the aim of the proper and efficient development of such areas
- (6) To examine and advise upon schemes submitted to the Commissioner for African Land Utilization and Settlement by a Provincial Commissioner after consultation with his provincial team
 - (7) When so directed to execute schemes
- (8) To obtain, examine and advise upon progress reports on schemes in process of execution
- (9) In preparing the schemes referred to above to recommend the conditions to be observed in relation to the paiticular use of land such as soil conservation measures, grazing control, etc
