**A BILL TO AMEND THE HOSPITAL SERVICES
(EUROPEAN) ORDINANCE, 1946**

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

Short title and
commencement

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Hospital Services (European) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Hospital Services (European) Ordinance, 1946, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 11th day of March, 1947 5

2. Section 12 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by deleting sub-section (2) thereof and substituting therefor the following new sub-section —

“(2) Every European who, under the provisions 10
of the Income Tax Ordinance, 1940, was resident in the Colony in the year immediately preceding any year of assessment commencing on or after the first day of January, 1945, shall pay in respect of each such year of assessment a contribution to the Fund 15
as follows —

Where his chargeable income for the year immediately preceding the year of assessment—

exceeded £1 but did not exceed £25, the sum of Sh 8
exceeded £25 but did not exceed £50, the sum of Sh 16 20
exceeded £50 but did not exceed £75, the sum of Sh 24
exceeded £75 but did not exceed £100, the sum of Sh 32
exceeded £100 but did not exceed £125, the sum of
Sh 40
exceeded £125 but did not exceed £150, the sum of 25
Sh 48
exceeded £150 but did not exceed £175, the sum of
Sh 56
exceeded £175 but did not exceed £200, the sum of
Sh 64 30
exceeded £200 but did not exceed £225, the sum of
Sh 72
exceeded £225 but did not exceed £250, the sum of
Sh 80
exceeded £250 but did not exceed £300, the sum of 35
Sh 88
exceeded £300, the sum of Sh 88 plus an additional
sum of Sh 8 for every £50 by which the chargeable
income exceeded £300

Provided that— 40

(a) the contribution payable in respect of the year of assessment commencing on the first day of January, 1945, shall be reduced by one-half,

(b) in computing the amount of the chargeable income of any person, any income accrued in, derived from, 45
or received in, the Colony and/or another East African territory before the date upon which such individual became resident in the Colony or after the date upon which he ceased permanently to be resident in the Colony shall not be taken into

account and the provisions of section 8 of the Income Tax Ordinance, 1940, shall not apply to such income, No 11 of 1940

(c) where an individual ceases permanently to be resident in the Colony or dies, the total contributions payable by him under the provisions of this sub-section shall be reduced by an amount equal to any contributions paid by him in respect of the year of assessment commencing on the first day of January, 1945, and of the year of assessment commencing on the first day of January, 1946, and

(d) the proviso to the definition of "resident in the Colony" contained in section 2 of the Income Tax Ordinance, 1940 shall not apply in determining whether or not an individual is resident in the Colony for the purposes of this Ordinance", No 11 of 1940

(b) by deleting sub-section (4) thereof

3. Sub-section (1) of section 21 is hereby amended by substituting the word "Authority" for the word "Auhority" which appears in the seventh line thereof Amendment of Section 21 (1) of the principal Ordinance

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to amend the Hospital Services (European) Ordinance, 1946, so as to give effect to the intention underlying the legislation

The benefits of the scheme were available as from the 1st day of January, 1946, and a contribution, based on income, is therefore payable in respect of that year. In order to ascertain the amount of that contribution, on the principals underlying the scheme, it is necessary to refer to the year of assessment for income tax purposes 1945, because the second payment of income tax in respect of that year of assessment was due at the end of March, 1946. It is therefore obvious that as the year of assessment 1945 is based on the income of the year 1944, the first payment due from an individual liable to the contribution must be based on his income for that year. No question arises of making a contribution in respect of the year 1944 or the year 1945. Those years are merely used as a basis for computing the contribution. The essential point is the date on which the first payment of contribution was due.

Opportunity has also been taken to make it clear that the contributions shall be payable only in respect of an individual's income while he is resident in the Colony for the purposes of the Income Tax Ordinance, 1940.

Clause 3 of the Bill seeks to amend a typographical error in section 21 of the principal Ordinance.

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be involved if the provisions of this Bill become law.
