VACANCIES IN GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS

Rural Industries Officer Social Welfare Organization

Salary scale £400 by £20 to £480 by £20 to £660 per annum (initial salary according to age, qualifications and experience) on Kenya European Civil Service terms and conditions of service. Candidates must be experienced in the supervision and development of rural industries must be good organizers and have business experience. A knowledge of ceramics would be an additional advantage.

Terms of service include the payment of a cost of living allowance, varying according to salary, at the following rates —

- Sh 18 to Sh 80 per month in the case of an unmarried officer
- Sh 110 to Sh 172 per month in the case of a married officer with no children

When not in occupation of Government quarters a housing allowance will be payable to a limit of $7\frac{1}{2}$ per cent of the salary when the salary does not exceed £520 per annum and 10 per cent of the salary when the salary exceeds that amount. In cases of hardship these allowances may be increased to $17\frac{1}{2}$ per cent of the salary when the salary does not exceed £520 per annum and 15 per cent of the salary when it exceeds that amount.

Applications should be submitted to the Adviser on Social Welfare, Private Post Bag, Nairobi, to reach him not later than 31st August, 1947.

Junior Examining Officers H M Customs

APPLICATIONS are invited for the following posts in the Kenya and Uganda Customs Department, and should be submitted in the applicant's own handwriting direct to the Commissioner of Customs, P.O. Box 61, Mombasa, to reach him not later than 25th August, 1947.

The scale of salary attached to the post is £240 by £20 to £300 by £20 to £360 per annum on Kenya European Civil Service terms and conditions of service, plus a cost of living allowance varying according to salary, at the following rates —

- Sh 88 to Sh 110 per month in the case of a single officer
- Sh 110 to Sh 166 per month in the case of a married officer, with or without children

Applicants should be between the ages of 19 and 23. Junior Examining Officers may be promoted to Examining Officers on a scale of £360 by £20 to £480 by £20 to £540 by £20 to £600 per annum before reaching the maximum of their grade on proof that they are fully capable of performing the more senior duties. A uniform allowance of Sh 240 per annum is made.

Terms of service for the above posts include 18 days' local leave per annum and vacation leave at the rate of $3\frac{1}{4}$ days for each month of residential service, free passages to United Kingdom for officer and wife after four-year tour, free medical treatment by the Government Medical Service, and participation in a contributory pensions scheme. When not in occupation of Government quarters a housing allowance will be payable to a limit of 10 per cent of the salary when the salary does not exceed £360 per annum, $7\frac{1}{2}$ per cent of the salary when the salary does not exceed £520 per annum and 5 per cent of the salary when the salary exceeds that amount. In cases of hardship these allowances may be increased to a maximum of 20 per cent of the salary if the salary does not exceed £360, $17\frac{1}{2}$ per cent of the salary if the salary does not exceed £520 per annum and 15 per cent of the salary if it exceeds that amount.

Candidates for these posts must produce evidence of a good standard of education. The duties of Examining Officers bring them into daily contact with all classes of the public, and tact, restraint and good bearing are essential requirements of an efficient officer. After a period of training, officers may be required to serve anywhere in Kenya or Uganda.

Accountant and Statistics Officer, Customs Department

Applicants, if not already members of the Government Service, should be under 45 years of age. The post is a pensionable one and the salary scale is £600 by £30 to £120 by £30 to £840.

The officer holding this post would be in control of all the accounting in a self-accounting department responsible for the collection of nearly £5,000,000 annually in customs and excise duties, the drafting of annual revenue and expenditure estimates, accounting control over inter-territorial trade in East Africa, the compilation of statistics governing the division of revenue, the preparation of the Annual Trade Report of Kenya and Uganda, the control over a branch of the department with a staff of three Europeans and forty Asian clerks. This officer is the Commissioner of Customs principal departmental adviser

on accounting and statistical matters. It is essential that he should have organizing ability and a definite aptitude for accounts and statistics.

(2) A complete entry of the goods included in a provisional entry shall be made in such a manner as if the provisional entry had not been made

2 (a) Provisional entry of dutiable goods, which the owner thereof desires to clear for home consumption, ex ship or ex King's Warehouse, is to be made on Customs Form No 6 (Blue) Provisional Bill of Entry

(b) Provisional entry of dutiable goods which the owner thereof desires to clear for home consumption from a bonded warehouse or a Government warehouse (other than a King's Warehouse), is to be made on Customs Form No 10 (White) Ex-Warehouse Import Duty Entry. All such ex-warehouse import duty entries are to be submitted in quadruplicate and the owner must give the following undertaking on each of the four copies of the entry —

"I hereby declare that I am unable to make a perfect entry of the within-mentioned goods and I undertake to make a perfect entry thereof within three months from the date hereof or forfeit the deposit specified above

3 In addition to the period of three months prescribed in section 65 (1), a general extension of three months published in General Notice No 123 of 1943 has also been granted, so that importers have a period of six months in which to perfect their provisional entries. This period of six months is considered ample and extensions beyond that time will not be granted. Any extensions beyond the period of six months granted prior to the issue of this notice will remain in force.

4 All deposits collected to provisional entries which remain unperfected at the expiration of six months from the date of the passing of the provisional entries will be automatically brought to account as revenue. In view of the undertaking given by the importer in the declaration on the provisional entry no official notice of the expiration of the period will be given to the importer.

5 Importers are notified that, henceforth, provisional entries must be perfected strictly in accordance with the provisions of section 65 (2) of the Customs Management Ordinance, 1926, that is to say, in respect of any provisional entry the importer must make a perfect entry, pay the correct duty due as shown by the perfect entry and then submit a claim, duly referenced to the perfect entry and provisional entries, for the whole of the deposit collected to the provisional entry. To avoid delay in refunding deposits, refund vouchers therefor may be lodged with, and will be checked at the same time as, the relative perfect entries. The importer's copy of the relative provisional entry (quadruplicate) must be attached to the refund vouchers.
