REVISION OF PROVINCIAL AND DISTRICT
BOUNDARIES IN RIFT VALLEY AND
CENTRAL PROVINCES

THE Committee appointed under Government Notice No. 379 of 16th April, 1946, to consider and report upon the advisability of effecting some alterations of the provincial and district boundaries in the Rift Valley and Central Provinces duly submitted its report to the Government.

The following is a summary of the recommendations:—

- (i) That the Laikipia and North Nyeri Districts should be amalgamated into one district to be known as the Aberdare District in and to be part of the Rift Valley Province;
- (ii) that the new Aberdare District should be staffed with the District Commissioner at Nanyuki and a District Officer at Thomson's Falls;
- (iii) that Rumuruti station should cease to be an Administrative District Headquarters;
- (iv) that the Samburu District should continue to remain part of the Northern Frontier Province by proclamation but be administered as part of the Rift Valley Province;
- (v) that the Samburu Sub-district should be constituted a separate district under its own District Commissioner;
- (vi) that the North Nyeri and South Nyeri Districts should be separated;
- (vii) that Nyeri Township should be excluded from North Nyeri District and placed in Central Province and South Nyeri District;
- (viii) that a new boundary be established between the new Aberdare District and the Nakuru District by the transfer of the following farms to the Aberdare District:—
 - (a) L.R. Nos. 6531/1 and 6593/5, west of Thomson's Falls;
 - (b) the triangle of farms, near Ol Joro Orok, which lie between the northern boundary of the Naivasha District Council's area and the boundary of the former Naivasha Administrative District; L.R. Nos. 7379 and 2648/3 within this triangle to remain in the Nakuru-Naivasha District;
- (ix) that provincial and district boundaries in the Mount Kenya and Aberdare Forest Reserves should follow the proposed boundaries for national parks and segmentation of national parks and forest reserves between different districts thereby be minimized;
- (x) that minor amendments of electoral areas under the Legislative Council Ordinance should be made corresponding to the amendment of the district boundary suggested;
- (xi) that Kijabe Township should be transferred from Central Province to Rift Valley Province as part of which it has been administered for some years;
- (xii) that the Mukogodo Area should be part of the new Aberdare District and administered by the District Commissioner, Nanyuki;
- (xiii) that the Mukogodo Area should be proclaimed a native reserve and set apart for the "use and enjoyment of natives".

The Government has decided to adopt in full recommendations Nos. (iv), (v), (vi), (vii), (viii), (x) and (xi), but on the subjects of recommendations Nos. (i) to (iii), (ix), (xii) and (xiii) the following decisions have been taken:—

The present Nyeri District will be redivided into two districts, both of which will remain in the Central Province. The new (North Nyeri) district will consist of the North Nyeri farms and Mukogodo, but Nyeri Township will be placed in the South Nyeri District. The District Headquarters of North Nyeri District will be at Nanyuki; but, by administrative arrangement, certain services will be rendered by the District Commissioner, South Nyeri, to residents in the neighbourhood of Nyeri Township. These proposals will be carried out as soon as administrative staff and buildings can be made available at Nanyuki.

The present Laikipia District will remain in the Rift Valley Province but the District Commissioner, Rumuruti, will transfer his headquarters to Thomson's Falls as soon as financial and administrative conditions make this move possible, and will retain the status of District Commissioner.

For the time being there will be no change in the existing administrative district boundaries within the Mount Kenya and Aberdare Forest Reserves.

The Mukogodo area will be administered by the District Commissioner, Nanyuki, as part of the North Nyeri District, but the proclamation of this land as a native reserve will be held in abeyance until a decision on its final boundaries has been reached.

Maps which illustrate the old and the new district and provincial boundaries have been deposited at the offices of the District Commissioner, Nyeri, the District Council, Nanyuki, and the Officer in Charge of Police, Thomson's Falls.
