KENYA AND UGANDA RAILWAYS AND HARBOURS

THE Railway Administration gives notice that as from 1st September, 1947, it proposes to improve the standard of meals served in its dining cars, ships and dak bungalows, and to withdraw the "austerity" meals which have been served since 1942 at a uniform charge of Sh 2. This type of meal, with few courses and limited helpings, was introduced as a temporary measure in a period of acute shortage of provisions and produce, when the number of passengers requiring meals made it impracticable to serve anything but meals of the simplest nature with few courses.

Now that travelling conditions are changing and food supplies more plentiful, it is proposed to move towards the normal pre-war standard of service. As from 1st September the charges for meals will be increased as in the list given below, and menus will be improved —

	Sh	cts
Breakfast	2	50
Luncheon	3	00
Afternoon tea (as at present)	1	00
Dinner	4	00

For those who do not wish to have the full *table d'hôte* meal, it will be possible to order one of the main courses at a reduced price which will be served *after* the ordinary meals. School children will be charged half-price for the full meal, or, if they prefer, they can be supplied with a plate of meat, vegetables and potatoes at a cost of Sh 1.

It may still be necessary, when an abnormal number of passengers is travelling (as when overseas passengers are moving to and from the Port), to revert to a simple type of meal so as not unduly to protract the sittings. When this is necessary, the price of the meal would be reduced accordingly.

Coincident with the introduction of the new meal rates, the price of bedding will be reduced as noted below —
