The duties of the post include the compilation of medical statistics in relation to the incidence of disease, and also the maintenance of records in respect of Government Hospitals, Medical Units and Staff. Previous experience in the use of medical terminology, in statistical work and a knowledge of current Government regulations will be an advantage.

Hydrographic Assistant Public Works Department Salary scale £500 by £20 to £600 by £20 to £660 per annum on Kenya European Civil Service terms and conditions of service. The duties of the post include (a) scrutinizing applications and plans for water rights and sanctions involving the checking of quantities of water, losses by canals, etc., (b) drafting of documents under the Water Ordinance, such as sanctions, licences, etc., (c) interviewing and advising applicants for water rights and conducting correspondence with them, (d) recording quantities of water authorized to be diverted in each drainage area and the priorities of the diversions, (e) issuing of instructions to Water Bailiffs in connexion with Water Law, (f) computations of rating table for gauging stations, computations and collection of river discharges, collation of rainfall and evaporation records, (g) receipt and distribution of correspondence of the Water Board, (h) the filing system of the Hydraulic Branch which includes water supplies, boring and general hydrographic work, (i) the receipt and recording of all applications under the Water Ordinance, the receipt of fees payable under the Water Ordinance, the filing of all sanctions and water rights issued, (j) the duties of Secretary to the Water Board, including the preparation of agenda for Water Board meetings, preparation of minutes, and dealing with matters arising out of the minutes.
