A BILL TO AMEND THE VAGRANCY ORDINANCE

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Vagrancy (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Vagrancy Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance)

Cap 63

Repeal and replacement of sub-section (3) of section 11 of the principal Ordinance

2. Sub-section (3) of section 11 of the principal Ordinance ⁵ is hereby repealed and the following sub-section substituted therefor —

“(3) Any native who, after being returned under the provisions of this section to the area reserved for the use of his tribe or sub-tribe, leaves such area, before the ¹⁰ expiration of three years from the date of such return, without the licence in writing of the Provincial Commissioner, or of a District Commissioner, of the Province in which such reserve is situated, shall be guilty of an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to ¹⁵ imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, and the magistrate may again order him to be returned to such area, and he shall be returned accordingly ”

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Under the law as it stands, any native who has been returned to his reserve as a vagrant is prohibited from leaving the area to which he has been repatriated without the licence in writing of the Provincial Commissioner or of a District Commissioner. It is considered that the law is too severe and that, after three years' residence from the date of his return, the native should be allowed to leave the reserve without obtaining any such consent

2 No expenditure of public moneys will be involved if the provisions of this Bill become law

 - (g) The Itare River on that portion of it that is within forest reserve, and its tributaries on those portions of them that are within forest reserve
 - (h) The Kipsonoi River on that portion of it that is within forest reserve, and its tributaries on those portions of them that are within forest reserve
- 3 I hereby declare that the following waters shall be open for the purpose of trout fishing —
- (a) The Jamji River down-stream from the point where the Sotik-Kericho main road crosses the river
 - (b) The Kiptiget River down-stream from the point, marked by a notice board, where the eastern boundary of the Buret Native Reserve meets its bank
 - (c) The Itare River on those portions of it that are outside forest reserve, and its tributaries on those portions of them that are outside forest reserve
 - (d) The Chemosit River from its formation down-stream
 - (e) The Kipsonoi River from the point where it leaves the forest reserve down stream

OBITUARY

His Excellency the Acting Governor regrets to announce the death in England on 1st September, 1947, of Robert Spencer Foster, C M G O B E late Director of Education, Kenya

Mr Foster was appointed Director of Education in Kenya on 1st October, 1944, and left the Colony on retirement because of ill-health on 15th October, 1945. He entered the Colonial Service in 1922 and worked in the Education Departments of Tanganyika as Superintendent of Education, in Uganda as Deputy Director of Education, and in Zanzibar as Director of Education, until 1943, when he was seconded to the Colonial Office as Assistant Educational Adviser to the Secretary of State for the Colonies. He served in this capacity for some 15 months until his appointment to Kenya as Director, and again after his retirement in December, 1945, until his death. For 25 years Mr Foster rendered outstanding and devoted service to the cause of education in Africa. His death will prove a serious loss to that cause, and will be mourned by his many friends and colleagues of all races.
