A BILL TO AMEND THE KING'S AFRICAN RIFLES ORDINANCE, 1932

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the King's African Rifles (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as No. 48 of 1932, one with the King's African Rifles Ordinance, 1932, hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance.

Amendment of section 2 of the principal Ordinance,

- 2. Section 2 of the principal Ordinance is hereby 5 amended by deleting the definition "battalion" or "unit" contained therein and substituting therefor the following new definition:
 - "'battalion' or 'unit' includes the Military Provost Staff Corps, the Coast Defence Battery, any unit of the 10 East African Construction Force and the King's African Rifles Guard Companies;".

Amendment of section 56 (3) of the principal Ordinance.

- 3. Sub-section (3) of section 56 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting a semicolon for the full stop which appears at the end of paragraph (g) 15 thereof, and by adding the following new paragraph:
 - "(h) contributions towards the funds of the East Africa Army Benevolent Fund.".

Amendment of section 73 (2) of the principal Ordinance.

- Sub-section (2) of section 73 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto, after para-20 graph (d) thereof, the following new paragraphs:—
 - "(e) For one year, with a prolongation of one year if his services are required by the Commander.
 - (f) For two years, with a prolongation of one year if his services are required by the Commander. 25
 - (g) For three years, with a prolongation of one year if his services are required by the Commander.".

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Clauses 2 and 4 of this Bill seek to amend the King's African Rifles Ordinance, 1932, so as to enable men to be enlisted in the East African Construction Force and the King's African Rifles Guard Companies, new units which it is intended to form.

Clause 3 seeks to amend section 56 of the principal Ordinance so as to enable payments to be made from the Military Fines Fund to the East Africa Army Benevolent Fund.

No expenditure of public moneys from Kenya funds will be involved if the provisions of this Bill become law

A BILL TO REPEAL THE NATIVE PASSES **ORDINANCE**

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

- This Ordinance may be cited as the Native Passes Short title. (Repeal) Ordinance, 1947.
 - The Native Passes Ordinance is hereby repealed. Cap. 138.

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to repeal the Native Passes Ordinance. That Ordinance became law on the 9th of April, 1900, and empowered the Governor in Council to make Rules for controlling the movements of natives into, out of, or within the limits of the Colony. The legislation is of a discriminatory racial character, and it is not considered necessary or desirable to retain it on the Statute Book.

No expenditure of public moneys will be involved if the provisions of this Bill become law.




