NYANZA DISTRICT COUNCIL (RESIDENT LABOURERS) ORDER

Marina Bakery, Nanyuki, Plot No. 9, Section A, Nanyuki

IN ACCORDANCE with the requirements of section 22 (1) of the Resident Labourers Ordinance, 1937, notice is hereby given that under the powers conferred upon it by section 21 of the said Ordinance, the Nyanza District Council proposes to amend its Resident Labourers Order of 1942 as follows:—

- (a) By adding thereto a new clause providing that in the Sotik Ward no resident labourer, native or Somali shall keep any cattle, sheep or goats;
- (b) by deleting from clause 6 the words "to the north-eastern corner" and substituting therefor the words "to the Mbogo river";
- (c) by providing in the Songhor Ward and in the portion of the Muhoroni Ward to which clause 6 of the Council's order does not apply, that—
 - (1) as from 1st January, 1949, no renewal contracts for a resident labourer shall provide for the grazing of more than 10 head of cattle over the age of 12 months and a total of 15 sheep or goats or a mixed herd of sheep and goats;

- (2) as from 1st January, 1951, no renewal contract for a resident labourer shall provide for the grazing of more than seven head of cattle over the age of 12 months and a total of 15 sheep or goats or a mixed herd of sheep and goats;
- (3) as from 1st January, 1953, no renewal contract for a resident labourer shall provide for the grazing of more than five head of cattle over the age of 12 months and a total of 15 sheep or goats or a mixed herd of sheep and goats;
- (4) as from 1st January, 1955, no contract with a resident labourer shall be entered into providing for the grazing of any cattle on a farm;
- (5) all cattle belonging to resident labourers shall be removed from the Songhor and Muhoroni Wards affected by this order not later than 30th June, 1955;
- (6) in the event of the death of a resident labourer during the course of a contract, and subject to the foregoing sub-sections of this paragraph, an adult son may, if agreeable to both parties, be issued with a resident labourer's contract and graze his father's cattle on the employer's farm;
- (7) an occupier of a farm may engage a resident labourer with not more than five head of cattle over the age of 12 months provided that such cattle are from the Songhor and Muhoroni Wards, but only during the period 1st January, 1949, to 31st December, 1954;
- (8) no resident labourer shall reside on an unoccupied farm unless such farm is under active production and is under adequate European supervision;
- (9) no resident labourer, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Council's order, shall be permitted to depasture cattle on a farm in excess of one head to five acres of suitable grazing, which is suitable for such cattle.

The purpose of the above order is in respect of—

- (a) to prohibit, in the Sotik Ward, the keeping of stock by resident labourers, native or Somalis;
- (b) to rectify the boundary of the area in the Muhoroni Ward in which no resident labourer, native or Somali may keep cattle or sheep;
- (c) to gradually eliminate cattle of resident labourers in the Songhor Ward and in the Muhoroni Ward over a period of six years.

A copy of the proposed order is deposited at the Council's Offices at Kericho, and can be inspected by any person at all reasonable times.

Any objections to the proposed amendments to the order must be lodged with the undersigned within 28 days after the date of publication of this notice.
