FOREST DEPARTMENT

TENDERS FOR CYPRESS THINNINGS AT KINALE, KIKUYU ESCARPMENT FOREST RESERVE

TENDERS are invited from sawmillers to fell and remove cypress thinnings marked by the Forest Department in the following areas:—

Area 1.—Kinale 2e North of the Blackwood plantation. About 107 acres. Estimated yield of thinnings about 830 tons of logs.

Area 11.—Kinale 2c and part of 2e South of Blackwood plantation, area about 38 acres. Estimated yield of thinnings about 130 tons of logs.

While every effort has been made to estimate the yield of thinnings correctly, no guarantee of quantity can be given, and payment will be made only for the actual quantity of logs obtained. Only trees marked by the Forest Department may be felled.

The basis of tender will be a royalty per cubic feet. All logs cut will be measured by the Forest Department by quarter girth (Hoppus) over bark, and payment will be made on these measurements. Only logs five inches diameter and over will be charged for. Lop and top will remain the property of the Forest Department.

Tenderers wishing to tender for both areas should submit a separate tender for each.

All trees marked must be felled and removed from the plantation within six months of the date of acceptance of tender, and all property and equipment of the licensee must be removed from Forest Reserve within eight months from the date of acceptance of tender.

The successful tenderers will be required to deposit with the Conservator of Forests the sum of Sh. 5,000 in respect of area 1 and Sh. 1,000 in respect of area 11 as minimum licence fees, which will be deducted from royalties which become due.

Tenderers are advised to inspect the areas and they may do this by arrangement with the Assistant Forester, Kerita, address P.O. Matathia. All trees for felling are marked with white paint.

Only tenders from established sawmillers will be considered. It will be a condition of the licence that the licensee shall send to the Conservator of Forests a monthly return of the quantity of sawn timber obtained from the logs removed under the licence. Successful tenderers will be required to provide satisfactory evidence regarding their financial resources and capability to undertake the work.
