A BILL ENTITLED
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EXCISE DUTIES
ORDINANCE, 1935

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

Short title	1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Excise Duties (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be read and construed
No 40 of 1935	as one with the Excise Duties Ordinance, 1935 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance)
Addition to Schedule to principal Ordinance	2. The Schedule to the principal Ordinance is amended 5 by adding thereto the following — <i>Matches—</i>
	<i>Sh cts</i>
(a) in boxes or packages containing not more than 100 matches, per gross of boxes or packages	1 44
(b) in boxes or packages containing more than 100 but not more than 200 matches, per gross of boxes or packages	2 88
(c) in boxes or packages containing more than 200 matches, for every gross of 100 matches	1 44

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill amends the Excise Duties Ordinance, 1935, by adding to the Schedule to that Ordinance provision for excise duty to be collected on matches manufactured in the Colony The duty is at the rate of Sh 1/44 for every gross of 100 matches or one cent for each box containing not more than 100 matches

The reason for this amendment is that there is a possibility that the manufacture of matches in the Colony may shortly be commenced and it is necessary for intending manufacturers to know the amount of excise duty which will be levied

No additional expenditure of public moneys is expected to be incurred if the provisions of this Bill become law

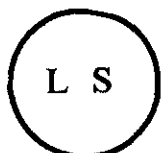

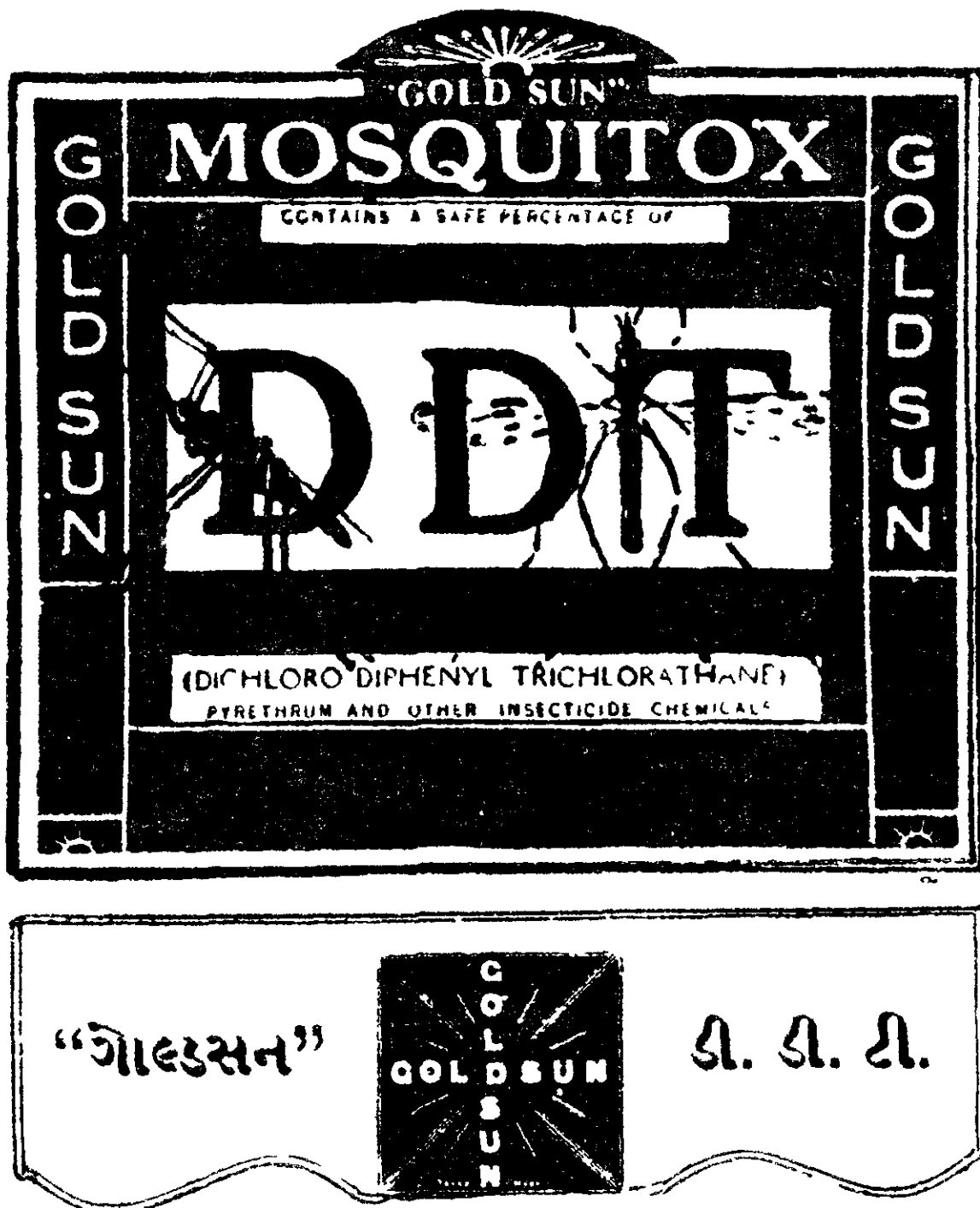

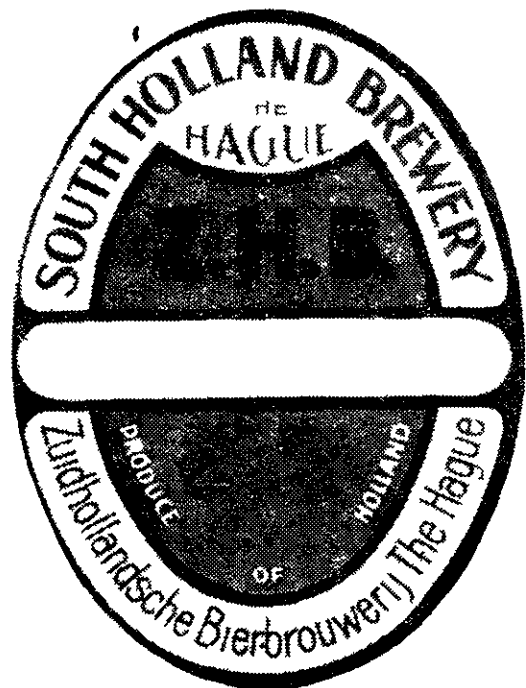
