Candidates should preferably be between the ages of 23 and 35 years and should have attained matriculation standard or the equivalent Preference will be given to applicants with laboratory experience, or a knowledge of laboratory technique

## (b) Field Assistants

The salary scale attached to these posts is £550 by £26 to £690 by £25 to £715

The duties are in the field in connexion with tsetse fly control which involves the management of trained African Assistants and labourers, and the routine study of tsetse and their habitats Candidates should have experience of living in the bush under reasonable conditions A school certificate (preferably with exemption from matriculation) or experience of field conditions in East Africa is a requisite qualification

Terms and conditions of service for these are as follows —

(a) A four-year contract,

(b) Eighteen days' local leave per annum, and vacation leave on expiry of contract at the rate of 4½ days for each completed month of residential service

(c) Free passage to the United Kingdom on expiry of contract in the case of a married officer with dependent children under 21, passages will be provided up to the cost of three adult passages

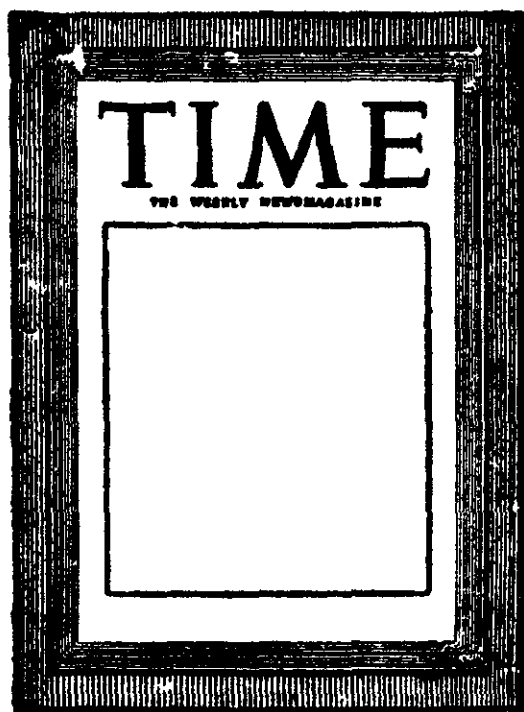
