The duties are in the field in connexion with tsetse fly control which involves the management of trained African Assistants and labourers, and the routine study of tsetses and their habitats Candidates should have experience of living in the bush under reasonable conditions A school certificate (preferably with exemption from matriculation) or experience of field conditions in East Africa is a requisite qualification


