A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE TO SUSPEND THE OPERATION OF THE FLAX ORDINANCE, 1939

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows—

Short title

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Flax (Temporary Suspension) Ordinance 1950

Temporary suspension of the Flax Ordinance 1939 No 40 of 1939 2. During the continuance in force of this Ordinance the operation of the Flax Ordinance 1939 shall, in relation to any flax crop subsequent to the flax crop of the year 1948 be 5 suspended

Expiry

3. This Ordinance shall continue in force until such date as it is terminated by the Governor by Proclamation published in the Gazette and shall then expire

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The production of flax has steadily decreased from 1,000 tons per annum in 1944 to only 56 tons in 1948 While it appears likely that a small flax-growing industry will continue to exist it is unlikely that it will regain its wartime volume of production and in these circumstances it is economically unsound that such a small industry should continue to support a Board It is proposed, therefore, that the affairs of the Board should be wound up but this cannot be accomplished immediately as, although the Board have informed growers that it will not accept responsibility for the 1949 crop, it will not be possible to dispose completely of the 1948 crop until the middle of 1950

This Bill will, therefore suspend in relation to every flax crop subsequent to the 1948 crop, the operation of the Flax Ordinance 1939 (Clause 2)

Clause 3 of the Bill provides for the Ordinance to remain in force until terminated by the Governor by proclamation

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be incurred if the provisions of this Bill become law
