#### A BILL ENTITLED

# AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PASSION FRUIT ORDINANCE, 1937

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows —

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Passion Fruit (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be read and construed as one with the Passion Fruit Ordinance, 1937 (hereinafter No 11 of 1937 referred to as the principal Ordinance)

Amendment of section 7 of the principal Ordinance

Sub-section (2) of section 7 of the principal Ordinance 5 is amended by substituting for the words "in the second half of each calendar year" the words "in the first half of each year"

#### MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

In the opinion of the Passion Fruit Board their operations can be more conveniently carried on if their financial year ends on the 31st December instead of on the 31st July This has been effected by an amendment of the Passion Fruit Rules, 1947, and does not entail an amendment of the Ordinance

In consequence however, of this change sub-section (2) of section 7 of the Ordinance which at present requires the Board to call a conterence for the election of members of the Board in the second half of each calendar year will require to be amended so as to permit the election of members in the first half of each year, that is to say, within six months of the end of the Board's financial year

This Bill will effect the necessary change

It is not expected that there will be any additional expenditure of public moneys if the provisions of this Bill become law

#### TRANS NZOIA DISTRICT COUNCIL HOSPITAL RATE—TRANS NZOIA DISTRICT
