Site 1—This is situated at approximately mile $26\frac{1}{2}$ from Nairobi on the east side of the Rift Valley Road and complises a ledge actually overhanging the road which is about 150 feet below it. It can be approached on a gentle gradient by an existing forest road which leaves the main road at approximately mile $25\frac{3}{4}$ from Nairobi. There is an uninterrupted view over the entire Rift Valley. The nearest known supply of water is in the loop of the railway to the northeast at $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles away.

SCHEDULE

Site 2—This site is on the west of the road approximately at mile $29\frac{1}{2}$ from Nanobi The site can be identified by an abandoned masonly plinth some $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft by $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft by $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft high standing beside the road It comprises five or six acres and would offer an uninterrupted view of the Rift Valley if some clearing was undertaken. There is no known water supply at the site, but water is believed to exist in the valley below at a distance of approximately half a mile

Site 3—This site is on the east of the road a little short of the 31st milestone from Nairobi and adjacent to a small streamlet which emerges from the Escarpment. The site comprises five or six acres. There is water on the site, but the view offered is not nearly so good as that from the other two sites.

BERLIN The first notice regarding this matter appeared in the Board of Frade Journal of 15th October, 1949 It is now notified for general information that the provisions of the Ordinance

- tor the Settlement of Securities in the British and American Zones have been extended to the French Zone and the Western Sectors of Berlin through corresponding Ordinances
- 2 The Ordinances apply only to securities expressed in German currency which were issued up to 8th May, 1945, by an enterprise which had its seat within the British, American or French Zones and the Western Sectors of Berlin and by a local government or municipality which had its ceat within the British, American or French Zones Securities issued by the Reich and its agencies do not come within the scope of the Ordinance
- 3 Paragraph 5 (a) of the first notice explains the procedure for secur ties deposited in the Western Zones. This procedure now applies equally to securities held deposited in the Western Sectors of Berlin whose rightful owners should apply under article 2 (2) of the Ordin ince for certificates of negotiability through the bank in which the securities are deposited Application should be made befor the 1st February, 1950
- 4 In respect of securities not covered by paragraph 3 above, the position is as follows -
 - (a) If the securities have been held outside Germany since 1st January, 1945, and are depos ted with a bank outside Germany, application may be made for certificates of negotiability to be issued by the investigating authori ties in Germany confirming the validity of such securities
 - (b) In all other cases, e.g. if the securities have been lost destroyed or are otherwise not available as evidence of the rightful owners rights and title, application may be made for such share in a collective document as may be determined by the investigating authorities in Germany after all applications have been received and dealt with The share will eventually be notified to the applicant and a new security issued in due course in respect thereof
- 5 As regards the method of completing an application under paragraph 4 above, claimants are advised to consult their bankers or brokers in the United Kingdom The necessary forms for the completion of applications under paragraph 4 above can be obtained through banks and brokers in the United Kingdom, who will be in a position to obtain expert advice on technical questions arising from the operation of the Ordinance
- 6 It will not normally be necessary to forward the actual securities or supporting documents to Germany
- 7 All securities to which the Ordinance applies and for which no certificate of negotiability is or may be issued will be null and void
