ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya,  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof,  
as follows —

Short title

**1** This Ordinance may be cited as the Nurses and Midwives Registration (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be read and construed as one with the Nurses and Midwives Registration Ordinance, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance)

**2** Section 4 of the principal Ordinance is amended in the following respects—

(a) by substituting for the words “the following seventeen members” where those words occur in sub-section (1) of the section the words “the following sixteen members”,

(b) by deleting paragraph (j) of sub-section (1) of the section and the marginal reference in relation thereto and by re-lettering paragraph (k) as paragraph (j), and

(c) by substituting for the word and letter “paragraph (k)” where it occurs in the proviso to sub-section (3) of the section the word and letter “paragraph (j)”

**3** Sub-section (2) of section 12 of the principal Ordinance is amended by substituting for the words “Any person who is not registered or enrolled under the provisions of this Ordinance but who is qualified to be so registered or enrolled, and who” the words “Any person who, not being registered or enrolled under the provisions of this Ordinance,”

**MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS**

Section 4 (1) of the Nurses and Midwives Registration Ordinance, 1949 (No 16 of 1949), provides that the Nurses and Midwives Council shall consist of seventeen members, of whom one is required to be a person appointed by the General Nursing Council of England and Wales. It appears that this particular provision was inserted without prior reference to the General Nursing Council, and upon being requested to make the necessary appointment they intimated that it was not practicable for them to do so. In the circumstances, therefore, it is proposed to amend the section so as to provide that the Council shall consist of sixteen members instead of seventeen. *Clause 2* of the Bill will effect this.

The opportunity has also been taken to amend section 12 (2) of the Ordinance so as to make it clear that it is an offence for an unregistered or unenrolled person to practise for gain as a nurse or midwife whether such person is qualified to be so registered or enrolled or not. As the existing section is drafted it is open to the construction that an unregistered or unenrolled person who is not qualified to be registered or enrolled does not commit any offence by practising for gain while a person qualified to be registered or enrolled does. *Clause 3* of the Bill will effect the desired amendment.

No additional expenditure of public funds will be incurred if this Bill becomes law.

## MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill amends the Employment Ordinance, 1938, in certain respects in which it is considered the Ordinance requires amendment. The nature of each amendment and the necessity for it is explained below

*Clause 2* of the Bill will amend the definition of "labour officer" in section 2 of the principal Ordinance so as to include in this definition "assistant labour officers". This amendment is rendered necessary by the creation of a new grade of labour officer to be designated "assistant labour officer". The present Resident Labour Officers for example will in future be known as assistant labour officers.

Sub-section (2) of section 23 of the principal Ordinance at present requires a deed of apprenticeship to be in a prescribed form. It has been found that no one form of deed can adequately be used for different types of apprenticeship engagements. *Clause 3* of the Bill will amend section 23 so as to require merely that such a deed shall be approved by the Labour Commissioner and shall not be so approved unless it contains certain provisions to be prescribed by rules.

Sub-section (5) (a) of section 39 requires recruit's licences to be issued by district officers. In practice the issuing of such licences can often be more conveniently carried out by labour officers. *Clause 4* accordingly, will amend paragraph (a) of sub-section (5) of section 39 of the principal Ordinance by inserting after the words "district officer" the words "or labour officer".

*Clause 5* of the Bill will amend section 73 of the principal Ordinance by the addition of a new sub-section which will place it beyond doubt that nothing in the section shall be deemed to prohibit an employer deducting from an employee's wages any money due as a contribution to an approved provident fund or superannuation scheme.

*Clause 6* of the Bill will amend section 79 of the principal Ordinance by inserting a provision enabling rules to be made for regulating the establishment, control and management of provident funds and superannuation schemes instituted for the benefit of employees. A proviso specifically requires that such rules shall contain a provision designed to safeguard the moneys of any such fund or scheme.

It is not expected that there will be any additional expenditure of public moneys if the provisions of this Bill become law.


