*Junior Land Assistant Lands Department*

APPLICATIONS are invited for one post of European Junior Land Assistant, Lands Department, Kenya. They should be sent to the Commissioner of Lands, P.O. Box 89, Nairobi, so as to reach him not later than 8th July, 1950.

Applicants in Government employ should submit their applications through the head of their department. Applications from candidates not in Government service should be submitted on the form of application for appointment to the Government service, copies of which can be obtained from the office of the Commissioner of Lands at the address given above.

The salary scale of the post is £670 by £20 to £690 by £25 to £790 a year and it is at present on a temporary basis for one year and temporary terms of service will apply, viz —

(a) For applicants not already in Government service 18 days' local leave a year and accumulative leave at the rate of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  days for each completed month of residential service.

(b) Free medical treatment by the Government Medical Service for the officer, his wife and unmarried children under 21 years of age.

An applicant already in the Government service if selected for appointment will be seconded to the post in a temporary capacity, will hold a *lien* on his substantive appointment in his parent department and will continue to be governed by the terms and conditions of service already applicable to him.

The duties of the post are connected with the administration, in a subordinate capacity, of Crown lands. The minimum qualification is a school certificate, but a knowledge of land law or training and experience in the work of land administration or estate management is desirable and will entitle a candidate to preference.

*Section Assistants Lands Department*

APPLICATIONS are invited for two permanent and two temporary posts of European Section Assistant in the Lands Department, Kenya. They should be sent to the Commissioner of Lands, P.O. Box 89, Nairobi, so as to reach him not later than 8th July, 1950.

Applications from candidates not in Government service should be submitted on the form of application for appointment to the Government service, copies of which can be obtained from the office of the Commissioner of Lands at the address given above.

The salary scale of the posts is £480 by £20 to £620. Conditions of service for the two permanent posts are the usual Government terms for such employees and include a two-year term of probationary service, 18 days' local leave a year, vacation leave at the rate of  $4\frac{1}{2}$  days for each completed month of residential service after 48 months' tour, free passages to U.K. and back for the officer and his wife after each completed tour of service, and free medical treatment by the Government Medical Service.

For the two temporary posts for applicants not already in Government service the usual terms of service as applicable to temporary employees will apply, these include 18 days' local leave a year, accumulative leave at the rate of 2½ days for each completed month of service and free medical treatment by the Government Medical Service.

An applicant already in the Government service, if selected for appointment, will be seconded to this appointment in a temporary capacity and will hold a *lien* on his substantive post in his parent department and will continue to be governed by the terms and conditions of service already applicable to them.

The duties of the posts are clerical and offer opportunity for advance to young men. No particular qualification is required other than school certificate standard of education but experience in Governmental office work and routine will be an advantage.

*Assistant Accountant Police Department*

Conditions of service are as follows —

(a) For applicants not already in the Government service appointment on probation for two years, for applicants who are already in the Government service a period of probation may also be necessary.

(b) Eighteen days' local leave per annum, and vacation leave at the rate of  $4\frac{1}{2}$  days for each completed month of residential service after 48 months' tour for officers under 40 and at the rate of  $5\frac{1}{2}$  days for each completed month of residential service after 40 months' tour for officers over 40.

(c) Free passages to the United Kingdom for the officer (and his wife if he is married) after completion of a tour of service, and return passages if returning for further service, in the case of a married officer with dependent children under 21 passages for himself and his family are provided up to the cost of three adult passages or the actual cost of the passages, whichever is the less.

(d) When in occupation of Government quarters 10 per cent of salary is charged as rent if the quarters are furnished and  $7\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of salary if they are unfurnished, when an officer occupies private quarters he may claim an allowance up to the amount by which the rent exceeds 10 per cent of his salary if the quarters are furnished and up to the amount by which the rent exceeds  $7\frac{1}{2}$  per cent of his salary if they are unfurnished.

(e) Free medical treatment by the Government Medical Service for the officer, his wife and unmarried children under 21.

Candidates should have a sound knowledge of accountancy and be capable of arranging the duties of accounts staff. A knowledge of Colonial Regulations, Financial Orders and accounting matters as applied to a Government self-accounting department will be an advantage.
