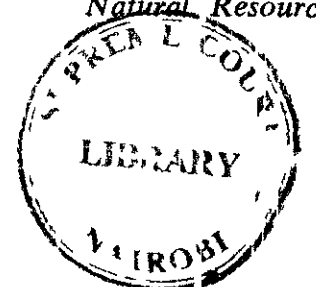

A plan of the plots may be seen at the office of the Registrar of Titles, Mombasa, at the Public Map Office of the Survey Department, Nairobi, or may be obtained from the Director of Surveys, Nairobi, on payment of Sh 5, post free. Applications should be submitted to the Registrar of Titles, P.O. Box 53, Mombasa, stating the plot desired in order of preference. Applications must be sent so as to reach the Registrar of Titles, Mombasa, not later than noon on the 26th August, 1950.

Grants will be for terms of 15 or 99 years and the special conditions applicable to each type of grant are set out at paragraphs (b) and (c) below. Applicants are requested to state clearly in their applications for which type of grant they wish to apply.

The plots have been surveyed but the survey has not been checked and the acreages shown in the Schedule are only approximate. The stand premium (if payable) and the annual rental payable in respect of each plot will be subject to adjustment when the precise areas have been ascertained.

(a) General Conditions

1 An applicant or his wife or vice versa who is already the owner of land at the coast is not eligible for a plot under this scheme.

2 The grant will be issued in the name of the allottee as stated in the letter of application.

3 Grants will be the subject to the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance (Cap 140) and titles will be issued under the Registration of Titles Ordinance (Cap 142).

4 Survey fees (Sh 80 per plot) and the fees (Sh 120) payable in respect of the preparation and registration of the title, together with stamp duty in respect of the grant must be paid within seven days of a demand therefor.

5 The grantee will be responsible for the estimated proportionate costs of roads and drains serving the plot, and will be required to pay the same within seven days of a demand therefor.

6 In the event of the grantee failing to comply with the provisions of Condition No 5 *supra*, any rights to a grant will be forfeited and any proceedings that may be necessary will be instituted for the recovery of the land. Moneys that may have been paid in respect of the plot will be forfeited to the Crown.

7 No building shall be erected on any plot unless plans (including block plans showing the position of such buildings clearly defined and showing a system of drainage for disposing of sewage, surface and sullage water on the said land), drawings, elevations and specifications thereof shall have been approved by the local authority and by the Commissioner of Lands, or such person as he may appoint. Such plans shall be submitted in triplicate to the District Commissioner, Mombasa, in the first instance within three months of the date of the commencement of the term.

8 The grantee shall duly and suitably connect such drainage system with any town drainage system when in the opinion of the local authority the latter system is so far completed as to enable the grantee reasonably so to do.

9 The use of the plot will be restricted to the erection of one private residence with the usual servants' quarters and outbuildings for the use of the grantee and his family only, and for no other purposes whatsoever.

10 The grantee shall not at any time subdivide the plot, except with prior consent in writing of the Governor.

11 The Governor or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon any plot and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes and drains, telegraph and telephone wires, and electric mains of all descriptions whether overhead or underground, and the grantee shall not erect any buildings in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing alignments of main or service pipes or the telegraph or telephone wires, and electric mains aforementioned.

12 The grantee shall pay such rates, taxes, charges, duties, assessments or outgoings of whatever descriptions as may be imposed, charged or assessed by any Government or local authority upon the land or buildings erected thereon including any contribution or other sum paid by Government in lieu thereof.

(b) Special Conditions—15 Year Leases

1 The grant will be for a term of 15 years from 1st October, 1950.

2 No stand premium will be payable, but the grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands within seven days of notification that his application has been approved the rent due from 1st October, 1950, to 31st December, 1950. In the event of the applicant failing to pay the proportion of rent due for the current year, together with the amount due in respect of survey, conveyancing and registration fees as set out at para-

graph 4 of the general conditions above within the time stated, the Commissioner of Lands may order that any deposit made by the purchaser be forfeited to the Government and the purchaser shall have no further claim to a lease of the plot.

3 The grantee shall have the right at any time before 30th September, 1960 on erecting a permanent building in accordance with approved plans and on paying the stand premium and annual rental on the full capital value of the land as assessed by the Commissioner of Lands at the date of his application to an extension of his term to 99 years on the conditions set out at paragraph (c) below, so far as applicable.

4 The grantee shall erect complete for occupation by 31st December, 1951, a building of approved design on proper foundations with a minimum construction of coral rag with makuti roof.

(c) Special Conditions—99 Year Leases

1 The grant will be for a term of 99 years from 1st October 1950.

2 The grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands within seven days of notification that his application has been approved the assessed stand premium in respect of the plot, together with the rent due from 1st October, 1950, to 31st December, 1950. In the event of the applicant failing to pay the assessed stand premium and the proportion of rent due for the current year together with the amount due in respect of survey, conveyancing, and registration fees as set out at paragraph 4 of the general conditions above within the time stated the Commissioner of Lands may order that any deposit made by the applicant be forfeited to the Government and the applicant shall have no further claim to a lease of the plot.

3 The grantee shall erect complete for occupation within 18 months of the date of the commencement of his grant a building of approved design on proper foundations, constructed of stone, burnt brick, concrete or coral blocks with a roofing of tiles, shingles or other permanent materials to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Lands.

4 The grantee shall not sell or transfer the plot nor enter into any charge (other than with the consent of the Commissioner of Lands for the purpose of raising a loan for building purposes) or agreement of sale in respect thereof within ten years of the date of commencement of the grant.

5 The grantee shall personally occupy the plot for at least three out of the first five years from the date of the commencement of the grant.
