APPLICATIONS FOR PERMISSION TO CUT AND REMOVE TIMBER FROM MARMANET FOREST RESERVE

APPLICATIONS are invited for permission to cut, remove, convert and sell on a temporary licence, all the remaining millable timber in an area of approximately 400 acres in Marmanet Forest Reserve, Thomson's Falls

The area has previously been worked over and all millable cedar and podo removed. It is estimated that there might be approximately 4,000 tons in the round of secondary hardwoods still remaining to be cut, but no guarantee of quantity can be given

The successful applicant will be required to erect a sawmill on a site approved by the Conservator and install and use milling machinery of a type approved by the Conservator. He will also be required—

(a) to commence the installation of the mill machinery within three months and to commence milling operations within six months of the granting of the licence,

(b) to produce a minimum of 2,500 c ft of sawn timber per month,

(c) to complete the cutting and removal of all millable timber from the area within three years of the granting of the licence,

(d) to submit to the Conservator monthly returns of stocks of timber on hand and timber dispatched from the mill on approved forms

The licensee shall pay to the Conservator royalty on all timber felled by him at such rates as may be prescribed by rules made under the Forest Ordinance or any amendments or alterations thereto which may be made during the currency of the licence

On the signing of the licence the licensee will be required to deposit with the Conservator the sum of Sh 1,000 as minimum licence fee which will be credited against any royalties which may become due from him
