ORDINANCE, 1949**

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Advocates (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be read and construed as one with the Advocates Ordinance, 1949, hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill will amend the Advocates Ordinance, 1949 (herein referred to as the principal Ordinance), in certain respects mainly of a minor nature. The most important amendments are as follows —

Clause 2 will amend section 3 of the principal Ordinance so as to entitle the Assistant Legal Secretary and any other duly qualified barrister or solicitor who holds office in the Legal Secretary's Department or in the East African Income Tax Department to practise in the Courts without the necessity of complying with the provisions of the Ordinance. The clause also deletes the provision whereby the Legal Adviser to the East African Railways and Harbours Administration was so entitled to practise. This amendment is rendered necessary by the abolition of the post of Legal Adviser to the East African Railways and Harbours Administration and the creation of the post of Assistant Legal Secretary to the High Commission.

Clause 3 will amend sub-section (1) of section 7 so as to specify with greater particularity the qualifications which entitle persons to be enrolled as advocates

Clause 5 will amend section 15 so as to make provision for the right of appeal by an advocate aggrieved by an order of the Court under the section admonishing or suspending him or striking his name off the Roll

Clause 8 will amend section 27 so as to make it clear that the provisions of the section are to be read subject to the limitations contained in the proviso to section 26

Clause 9 will amend section 37 so as to place it beyond doubt that both the body corporate and any director, officer or servant of it are guilty of the offence created by the section

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be incurred if the provisions of this Bill become law

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

By the Alteration of Time Ordinance, 1936 the provisions of which have been incorporated in the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap 1 of the Revised Edition), it was provided that time within the Colony should be two-and-three-quarters hours fast on Greenwich mean time. During the war this Ordinance was amended by Defence Regulations so as to provide that time should be three hours fast on Greenwich mean time. Both Tanganyika and Uganda amended their laws similarly and Zanzibar has recently followed suit. The Defence Regulation will expire on the 10th December next and as it is considered that there are good reasons for permanently adopting a standard time which is three hours fast on Greenwich mean time, it is necessary to amend section 31 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance. This Bill will accordingly effect the necessary amendment.

AWARD OF A BAR TO THE COLONIAL POLICE MEDAL
FOR GALLANTRY

No 2153 Constable Kibehon Arap Kori

HIS MAJESTY the King has been graciously pleased to approve the award of a Bar to the Colonial Police Medal for Gallantry to Constable Kibehon Arap Kori of the Kenya Police

On the 16th April 1950 at about 8.00 p.m. a police patrol of four constables came upon a party of five Derobo tribesmen armed with spears and swords and was immediately attacked by them. In the initial attack No 2153 Constable Kibehon Arap Kori received a very serious head wound with a sword which caused a wound of five inches long and one inch deep. Despite this, however, the constable grappled with his assailant and overpowered him. He then went to the help of another constable who was about to be speared by another tribesman, tackled him and arrested him. No 2153 Constable Kibehon then collapsed through loss of blood.

Constable Kibehon Arap Kori was previously awarded the Colonial Police Medal for Gallantry for conspicuous gallantry in the execution of his duty on the 7th of June, 1946, when with disregard for his own safety and despite the danger caused by the presence of live ammunition he assisted in fighting a fire on board a lighter at Mombasa (Government Notice No 942 of the 26th October, 1946)
