**A BILL ENTITLED  
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE INDUSTRIAL  
LICENSING ORDINANCE**

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Industrial Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be read and construed as one with the Industrial Licensing Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance

2. The principal Ordinance is amended by inserting <sup>5</sup> therein immediately after section 10A the following new section—

Power to

licence

10B (1) Notwithstanding the fact that a declaration has been made under sub-section (2) of section 10 or under section 10A of this Ordinance the Council may, <sup>10</sup> with the consent in writing of the licensee on whose application such declaration has been made, in its discretion grant or refuse an application for a conditional licence

(2) Every application for a conditional licence shall <sup>15</sup> have attached to it the consent in writing of the licensee on whose application a declaration has been made under sub-section (2) of section 10 or under section 10A of this Ordinance together with the conditions, if any, on which such licensee has so consented but shall otherwise be made <sup>20</sup> and dealt with in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance

(3) Where a conditional licence is granted, then during the period of its validity in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (4) of this section— <sup>25</sup>

(a) it shall, notwithstanding the provisions of section 15 of this Ordinance, be subject to the conditions, if any, referred to in sub-section (2) of this section,

and <sup>30</sup>

(b) it shall be subject to such other conditions as the Council may attach thereto in accordance with the provisions of section 9 of this Ordinance,

and

(c) it shall not be transferable, <sup>35</sup>

and

(d) it shall, save as is otherwise in this section provided, be subject to the provisions of this Ordinance

(4) A conditional licence shall be valid only during <sup>40</sup> the currency of the declaration which gave rise to the grant of the conditional licence and a period of three months thereafter

Provided that the Council may, on the application of the holder of such conditional licence, extend the validity <sup>45</sup> thereof for such further period, not exceeding three months, as the Council may think fit

## MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

In 1949, the Industrial Licensing Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance), was amended to enable the East African Industrial Council at the time of granting a licence to declare that for a specified period no similar licence would be granted

It is now considered that the Council should be empowered to grant a conditional licence during the period for which the declaration extends if the licensee to whom the first licence has been granted agrees and subject to such conditions as may be agreed upon between the first licensee and the applicant for the conditional licence

This Bill will insert a new section to provide for this

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be involved if the provisions of this Bill become law

## MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Pyrethrum Ordinance does not contain any provision empowering the Pyrethrum Board to borrow money for the purposes of the Ordinance. It has been represented that such a power is essential to enable the Board adequately to carry out its functions under the Ordinance and this Bill will accordingly make the necessary provision

## GOVERNMENT AFRICAN OVERSEAS BURSARIES, 1951

AS IT will be extremely difficult to obtain places in United Kingdom universities and colleges in 1951, it is essential that all applications for admission in October, 1951, should be received by the Director of Colonial Scholars in London in December, 1950. It will therefore be necessary for applications for Government African Overseas Bursaries to be received by the Director of Education by 30th November, 1950. It will not be possible for the Director of Colonial Scholars to secure places for any students who apply after that date. No applications or a bursary received after 30th November, 1950, can therefore be considered unless the applicant has already secured admission to a university or college.

Persons wishing to apply for a Government African Overseas Bursary should obtain the necessary forms from either the Director of Education, Nairobi, or the Provincial Education Officers at Kisumu, Nakuru, Nyeri and Mombasa. The completed forms must be returned through the appropriate Provincial Education Officer so as to reach the Director of Education not later than 30th November, 1950.

It should be noted that no application for a bursary will ordinarily be considered unless the candidate has satisfactorily completed a course of education at Makerere College.

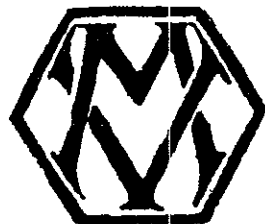
