TENDERS are invited for the right to cut and remove all fuel and bark from wattle trees standing in Compartment No 9 (g) (approximate area, 78 acres) of the Muguga Forest Reserve.

The basis of tender will be a price per acre. The accepted price should not be construed in any way as encouraging or supporting any possible claim for a higher price for fuel to the consumer. The successful tenderer will be required to observe the relevant Price Control Regulations.
