- "(1) To study in detail on the ground, where required, the boundaries of such existing forest areas as the Member for Agriculture may direct
- (2) To make recommendations, accompanied by full supporting reasons, for the inclusion within any forest area of any land contiguous to it which they deem should properly be included within such forest area, and to indicate the degree of urgency and importance which they attach to the acquisition of such areas outside the existing forest areas
- (3) To take local evidence and to make recommendations as to any excision from such forest areas as they may deem fit with full reasons for such recommendation
- (4) To make general recommendations for the declaration of new forest areas "
